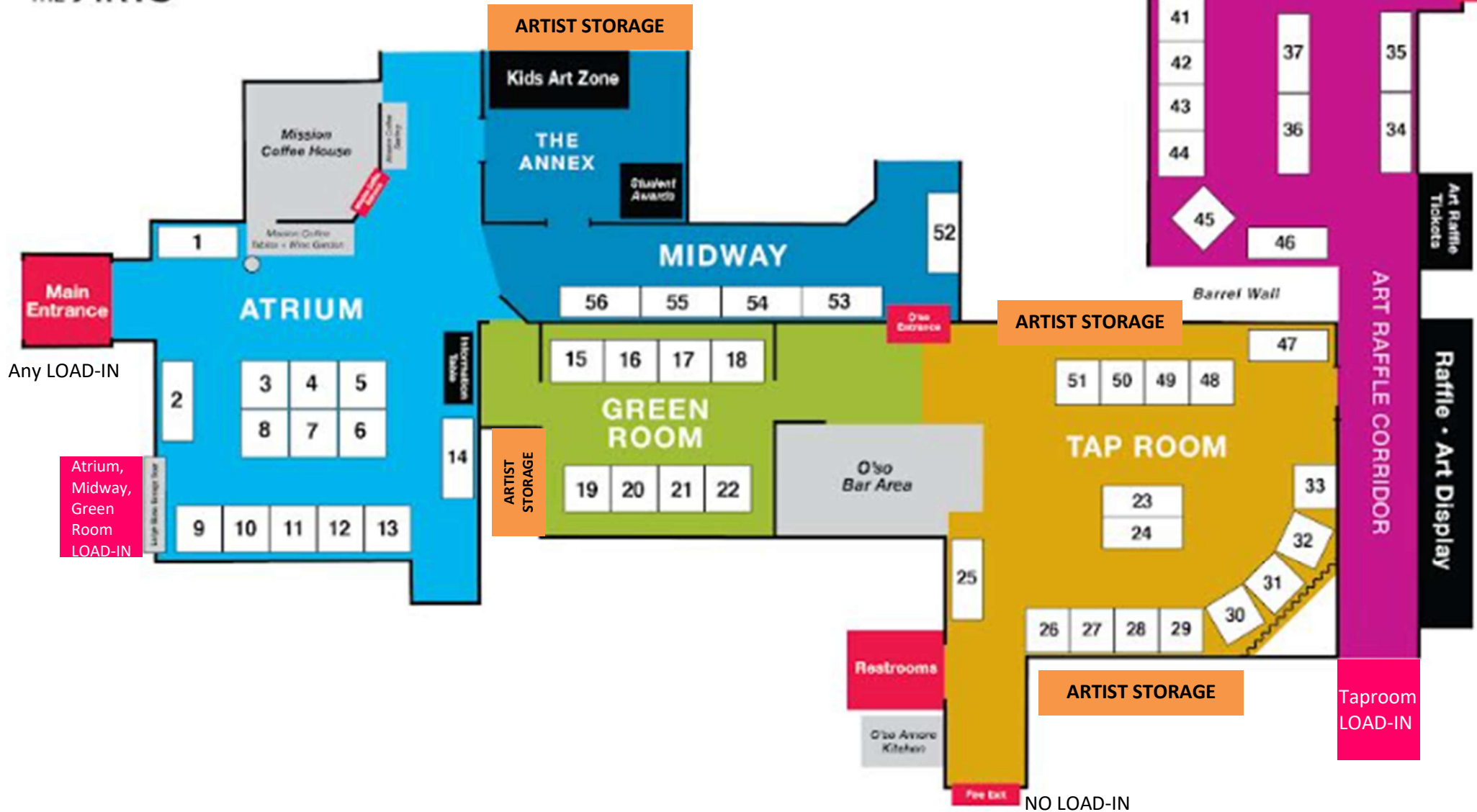

GREEN ROOM ARTIST BOOTH SET-UP:

Booths #15-22

DATE: Sunday April 6, 2025 **HOURS:** 10am-4pm

LOCATION: Artist & Fare and O'so Brewing Company - 1800 Plover Road, Plover WI, 54467

- Plover is four miles from Stevens Point
- Artist & Fare is located off Interstate 39 and near Menards, Metro Market Grocery, Starbucks, and other restaurants, stores, and hotels.

SET-UP DATES & TIMES:

- Saturday, April 5 from 3pm-9pm
- Sunday, April 6 starting at 6:30am. Festival starts at 10am.

SECURITY: There is no security for artwork on Saturday evening. Set-up your artwork at your own risk. Artist & Fare and O'so Brewing Company is open to the public until 11pm on Saturday Evening. This meeting room will be locked overnight.

CHECK-IN: Please check-in with the event coordinator, Sharon Fujimoto, at the information booth in the Atrium before you start set-up.

- Collect your booth sign and name tag at check-in.
- Sign up for booth sitter if needed.

GREEN ROOM LOAD-IN: Artists may load in through the front doors of Artist & Fare or the garage door.

- Garage door can NOT stay open. Please wait for someone to open the garage door for you to conserve heat in the space. The event space is heated but can be chilly if doors are left open during set-up and as guests enter throughout the event. Please dress accordingly.
- 15-minute unloading time at front of building. **Please do NOT leave your vehicle parked in front of the building while you are setting up.** Please be considerate of other artists that need to load-in. You may park in the lot and cart in.
- We do NOT provide any carts for load-in

IMPORTANT NOTE:

- O'so Brewing houses a beer museum in the Green Room space, please be mindful of all items displayed on the walls.
- **(Booths #15-18) All booth structures should be set-up at least 6 inches away from the walls.** Do not lean anything against the walls. Our ability to use this meeting space for artists depends on protecting the museum displays. No storage room immediately adjacent to booth space.
- (Booths #19-22) There is minimal storage directly behind your booth space. A walkway behind the booths along the wall must be left clear of all boxes or other items.

ARTIST STORAGE: Artist storage is available in the Green Room, also available behind the annex.

PARKING: There is plenty of free parking for artists and guests near each entrance.
