Shannon O'Lone introduced our guest speaker Ross Conrad. His subject was Bees Wax: Production, Collection, Processing and Uses.

CiCi introduced Courtney Dingerson, A 2024 scholarship winner, to the membership. Courtney gave us a run down on her studies with the bee lab at University of Florida.

Officer reports as follows:
