ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

RIVERWOOD PROPERTY OWNER'S ASSOCIATION a Non-Profit Corporation

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twentyone (21) years or more, at least two of whom are citizens of the
State of Texas, acting as incorporators of a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Texas, to hereby adopt the
following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is RIVERWOOD PROPERTY OWNER'S ASSOCIATION.

ARTICLE TWO

This corporation is a non-profit organization and all membership fees, contributions or funds received from any source shall be used for the purposes set forth in these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE THREE

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE FOUR

The purposes for which the corporation is created is to promote, beautify and protect the interests and welfare of owners of property in a tract of land situated in Waller County, Texas containing 196.87 acres of land situated in the Jared Grace Survey, Abstract 30, Waller County, Texas, an unrecorded subdivision prepared and platted by Farmer and Winslow, Inc. Engineers, dated October 1978 and known as Riverwood, Riverwood I and Riverwood II, by maintaining the common properties of the subdivisions beautifying the properties, and in general promoting the best interests of the owners of properties in said subdivision.

ARTICLE FIVE

The members of this corporation shall consist of owners, through equity contracts or through warranty deeds, of property in Riverwood, Riverwood I and Riverwood II as described in Article Three who have applied for membership in this

Association and who pay monthly dues as set by the membership from time to time. The membership shall adopt by-laws at the membership organizational meeting and may amend such by-laws from time to time.
