#### A REFLECTION ON TODAY'S GOSPEL FROM A DOMINICAN FRIAR:

Jesus said to the disciples"

"Whoever wishes to come after me must deny themselves,

take up their cross and follow me."

Reflection:

The disciples didn't realize what they were getting into when they said "Yes" to Jesus' invitation to follow him? They discovered that serving God by responding to Jesus' call, even though a good thing to do, does not quarantee smooth sailing. But they also learned to trust that God was with them as they tried to respond to Jesus' call, "Come follow me." So we ask ourselves:

Do we hear Jesus' call now, "Come follow me?" How shall we respond? Can we trust that God will be with us in that response?
