Bavarian Chicken - \$13.95 ☺

Grilled chicken breast topped with melted Swiss cheese and ham.

Chicken breast breaded in our homemade Ronneburg schnitzel blend and grilled.

Beef

Oven Baked Steak - \$15.95

Tender beef slowly baked in its own gravy with caramelized onions.

Rouladen - \$14.95

A German specialty. Slow cooked tender beef steak layered with bacon, German mustard, carrots, and onions wrapped around a pickle spear. Baked in a special gravy.
Comes with spätzle.

Sauerbraten - \$14.95

Another German specialty of the Ronneburg. Marinated beef in a special blend of seasonings and sweet and sour sauce made with Amana wine. Samples are available.

Wiener Schnitzel - \$14.95

Veal breaded in our special schnitzel blend and grilled.



Fish

Tilapia - \$12.95 ☺

Grilled and seasoned whitefish fillet with lemon pepper.

Sandwiches

Reuben - \$9.95

Served on marbled rye bread with corned beef, sauerkraut, and swiss cheese.
Thousand Island is served on the side.

Pork Tenderloin - \$8.95

A thick, tenderized pork cut that is breaded and fried. Served on a bun.

Brat & Kraut - \$6.95

Mild bratwurst from our local Amana meat shop.
Served on a bun with sauerkraut on the side.

Swissburger - \$9.95

Swiss cheese with grilled onions and mushrooms.

Hot roast beef sandwich covered in gravy.
Served with potatoes in the center.

Wiener, jäger, or hähnchen served on either a brioche bun or marbled rye bread.

Oven Baked Steak - \$18.95

Slowly baked for several hours in its own gravy with caramelized onion.

Rouladen - \$17.95

Tender, thin cut of beef steak that is layered with bacon, onions, carrots, and German mustard then wrapped around a pickle spear. Slowly baked in its own gravy.
Limited amount available per day.

Sauerbraten - \$17.95

Tender cuts of marinated beef made with Amana wines with a special blend of spices and sweet and sour sauce.
Samples are available.

Wiener Schnitzel - \$17.95

Tenderized veal that is breaded in our own special schnitzel blend of spices and grilled.

History of the Ronneburg Restaurant

The restaurant is named after the "Ronneburg" castle in Hesse, Germany. The castle has significance to the Amana community because it provided refuge for the town ancestors when they were fleeing religious persecution in the 18th century. Several pictures and paintings of the Ronneburg Castle can be seen in our dining rooms.

Built in 1860, the Ronneburg Restaurant was a communal kitchen serving Amana residents until 1932. The atmosphere in the dining rooms during the communal era differed considerably from now. Men ate at one table while the women and children ate at another. You were allowed fifteen minutes for your meal and you were expected to use it just for eating. Conversation was frowned upon and music was strictly forbidden.

In 1950, the Ronneburg opened its doors as a family restaurant and has been serving German style food ever since!
