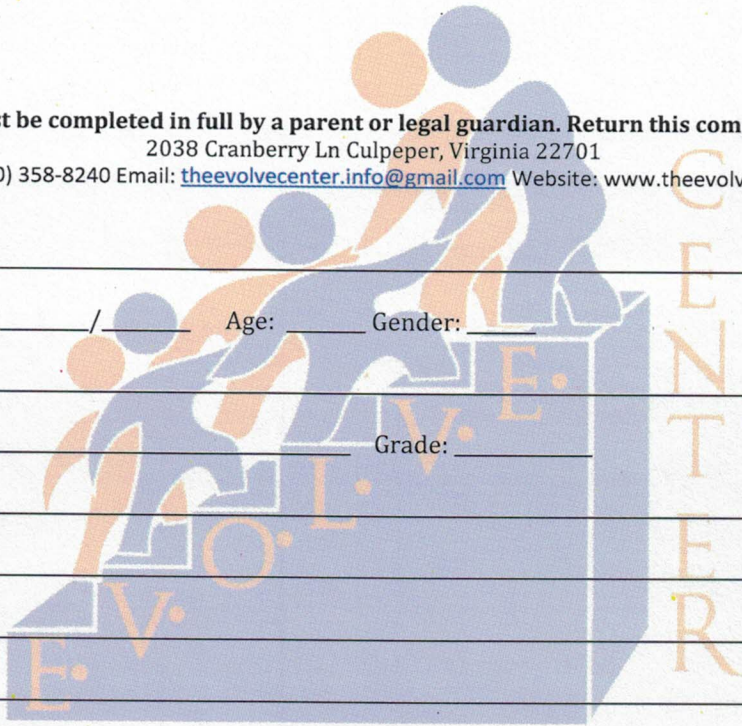

Monthly Donation

The E.V.O.L.V.E Center and its programs are funded by donations and fundraisers. To ensure that we can continue to provide the youth with opportunities to be successful through our program, we ask for a monthly donation of \$25 per participant. For 2 or more participants we ask for a monthly donation of \$40. Your donations will help provide snacks, food, transportation for educational field trips as well as any other field trips and any other materials that may be needed. **All donations are due by the 15th of every month. If you're donation isn't paid by the 15th your child(ren) cannot return until your donation is paid in full. If your donation isn't paid by the 1st of the next month your child(ren) will lose their spot if there are other children on the waiting list.**

Field Trips

Part of your monthly donations will cover **some but not all field trips that we will take.** However, depending on the cost of the field trip you may be asked to cover half of the cost. **If you have more than 2 children enrolled in the program, you will be responsible for the cost of all field trips after the 2nd enrolled child.**

Food And Snacks

A small meal, drink and a snack will be provided. Please remember to let us know of any allergies your child(ren) may have.

Transportation

Transportation is available for any child(ren) who needs it **who live in the town limits.** We ask that someone at least 16 years of age be present at pick up and drop off. If there is no one at least 16 years of age present for pick up your child will not be provided transportation. If there is no one at least 16 years of age present at drop off your child(ren) will not be released. You will need to come to the address provided on this form to pick your child(ren) up. If no one is available for drop off more than 3 times within a 60-day period, you will be responsible for providing transportation for your child(ren).

RELEASE OF LIABILITY



Behavior Guidelines

We expect participants to always act respectfully when they are on our property or participating in activities off site. Participants are to behave in a mature, responsible way and respect the rights and dignity of others.

Our 3 core values are:

1. **Respect:** Participants will respect staff, volunteers, themselves, each other, guests, and equipment.
2. **Honesty:** Honesty will be the basis of ALL relationships.
3. **Responsibility:** Participants will take responsibility for their actions.

Discipline Procedures

When a participant does not follow the behavior guidelines, we will take the following action steps as behavior progresses:

1. Staff/Volunteer(s) will redirect the participant to more appropriate behavior.
2. If inappropriate behavior continues, the participant will be reminded of behavior guidelines and rules, and the participant will be asked to decide on action steps to correct his/her behavior.
3. If the participants behavior still does not meet expectations and is affecting the other participants, he/she guardian will be contacted to pick them up. The guardian will receive a written warning that must be signed.
4. After receiving two written warnings the participant will be dismissed from the program and will not be permitted to sign up in the future. Please review these rules with your child prior to the first day of participating in the program. The staff will review these rules with your child on the first day of the program as well. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Examples of unacceptable behavior:

1. Refusal to participate in activities or cooperate with staff/volunteers.
2. Using profanity, vulgarity, or obscenity of any kind.
3. Stealing or damaging property (personal or program property)
4. Teasing, making fun or bullying of other participants, staff, volunteers, or guests.
5. Endangering the health or safety of other participants, staff, volunteers, or guests.
6. Leaving without permission.
7. Fighting of any kind (may also result in suspension or permanent dismissal)

Bullying Policy

At The E.V.O.L.V.E Center, bullying is inexcusable and unacceptable, and we have a firm policy against ALL types of bullying. Each participant is expected to treat all other participants with respect. If a participant has difficulty meeting this expectation, guardians may be called, and it can result in dismissal from the program.

Our leadership addresses all incidents of bullying seriously and trains staff/volunteers to promote communication with participants. We work together as a team to ensure that participants gain self-confidence, make new friends, and go home with a good experience.
