Watercraft Stickers

A gentle reminder, all stickers must be applied to your *ELDA registered* watercraft. Only ELDA registered watercrafts are allowed on Elk Lake, kayaks and paddle boards are included in this designation. Any visitors/renters bringing in their own watercrafts are not permissible on the lake. Best advice is, immediately put your stickers on your water craft (don't leave them on the kitchen table lol).

From the Fish Committee

Over 900 walleyes, between 6 and 8 inches, were stocked in the lake in early November.
