Call to Order & Introductions

President George Firmstone called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone at 10:04. The membership held a moment of silence for ELDA's long time committee and board member and good friend Michael Matzko who passed away last month. George proceeded with the meeting, asking everyone present to introduce themselves and sign in. Sign-in sheet attached (addendum 1)

• Recording Secretary's Report – Michele Ryan for Kathy Emanuelson, There are two sets of minutes.

The minutes of the August 10th, 2024, General Membership Meeting were shared electronically with ELDA general membership for their review prior to the meeting. A motion to approve the minutes was made by: John Parker, seconded by: Jack Mulka. Passed with no one opposed.

The minutes of the April 27th, 2025, board meeting were shared electronically with ELDA board members for their review prior to the meeting. A motion to approve them was requested, to be made by board members only. The motion made by: Millie McCarthy, seconded by: Chris Mann and passed with no corrections and no one opposed.

- Corresponding Secretary's Report Millie McCarthy reposted that ELDA has 148 members, with 160 active lake rights. All members have paid their dues. There are 51 stickered boats in the up to 19HP category; 50 personal watercraft, 123 boats with 20-75HP and 527 stickered manual craft on our lake.
- Motion to approve the Corresponding Secretary's report was made by Jon Walko, seconded by Chris Mann and passed with no opposed.
- Treasurer's Report Pat Walker shared the Profit & Loss Summary for 8/1/24 through 7/12/25, the Balance Sheet dated 7/12/2025 and the checkbook transaction detail dated 8/1/24 through 7/12/225. All are attached (addendum 2). Pat noted ELDA's cash in checking is \$17,832.44, and accounts are in the black and good. He'll need to order some checks. Pat has received memorial donations in memory of Frank Larkin and Mike Matzko. Motion to approve the treasurer's report was made by Jon Walko, seconded by Paul Szwayka and passed with no one opposed.
- Township Meeting Report On the topic, Pat asked about the construction on Elk Lake drive. The bridge at Little Keen Road is out until the end of September. Brian Devaney offered to contact PennDOT about the road.

- Patrol Report Joe Farrell reported that there is nothing to report. He noted that there are still some people who haven't put their stickers on their watercraft.
- Boating and Safety John Parker reported to the meeting. He noted that joe Farrell is not a certified officer. He patrols, can tell people if they're going the wrong way, too close to the shore, etc. He is not a boat commission officer. John asked if anyone else would be interested in serving on the Boat and Safety Committee? No one volunteered at the meeting. Don Hagerty noted that someone passed by in a boat while his grandkids were swimming. Please remember to give swimmers space. John has seen illegal kayaks with legal stickers. He requests that members do NOT give out stickers to people not residing on the lake. It can bring invasive weeds from other lakes.

Jack Mulka noted that the Matzko family have made memorial contributions to the Boat and Safety Committee for educational opportunities.

- Fish Committee Jack Mulka reported that trout were stocked last spring and at this point should be 16-18". There has been great fishing this spring by many reports. He's caught more Walleye than previous years, 20" and larger. Reproduction in the lake is working, as demonstrated by the variance of fish sizes. Jack notes that all shorelines are represented on the Fish Committee, and the invitation stands to anyone who would like to join the committee. Pat asked about the catch and release rule. The PA fish law limits fishermen to 6 bass per day with a minimum size of 12". The ELDA policy is a maximum of 2 bass per day, minimum 15" and 2 Walleye, minimum 18". It was requested that this is noted in the ELDA Newsletter.
- Water Quality Report Dave Stanton reported that Elk Lake's water quality is very good, with low phosphorus levels. July last year there was a 65 E. coli rating in one location. In August, numbers were extremely low everywhere, 1 or less. To preserve this, please take goose poop out on land, do not wash into the lake. And as always, a reminder to maintain septic systems and keep fertilizer out of the lake. Dave will have July's preliminary water quality report at the August meeting.
- Fracking Committee Report Dave Stanton reports there is no report.
- Dam report Fred Stanton reported that the dam passed inspection. He noted there are 2 cracks with seepage in the concrete weir, but as of right now we just need to monitor the situation. Paul Szwayka suggested we do something before it gets worse. The person who previously made repairs and improvements to our dam has retired, so ELDA needs to find someone new to get an estimate. An inquiry was made about boats getting closer to the dam and if that contributes to the problem. George stressed the importance of keeping docks on the shoreline near the dam securely tied to the shore.
- Committee Appointments
 - Financial Records Review Committee Pat Walker reported that the annual review of financial records will be completed this month with Vince Gatti and Randy Berini. The report will be presented at the August meeting.

 Nominating Committee – John Parker reported that the committee met in April to review the board members.
