1: Take the Dolmuş to Iztuzu Beach from the Dolmuş stop opposite the Çağrı Restaurant . Check the board for frequency of the return Dolmuş.



2: Once you arrive at the beach let the Dolmuş park up at the refreshment bars . Walk towards the refreshment bars from the Dolmuş stop and turn right along the path behind the car park where you should see these signs.



3: Follow the track to the back entrance to the Turtle Hospital .



4: After looking around the hospital come out the front entrance and turn left along the track away from the beach.



5: Dolmuş end of the beach features Iztuzu Lake photographed below, and the pine woods that surround it. There is a pleasant and easy walk through the woods behind the hospital. Once past the picnic areas the path slowly disappears and you will be following the goat tracks.
