



Olathe North High School Quarterback Club Scholarship Guidelines

Requirements for Application

- Candidates must have been enrolled at Olathe North and played football and completed each football season (barring injury) at Olathe North in each year.
- Parent/Guardian/Player must have been a paid member of the Olathe North Quarterback Club for **EVERY** year of their player's eligibility.
- Quarterback Club dues must be paid no later than September 30th of each year.
- Candidates must achieve a cumulative GPA of **3.0** (unweighted) in high school. Screenshot of GPA from StudentVue/ParentVue will be required.
- Return the completed application and associated essay by January 31st, 2026 along with GPA, to onqbclub@gmail.com. (Current Seniors only)

Applicant Review Process

- The Quarterback Club Scholarship Committee (President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer) will jointly review each player's application and associated documentation, to ensure full eligibility requirements have been met.
- Following the review process, a final list of candidates will be compiled for approval after verifying high school GPA.
- Any player receiving an athletic scholarship to an NCAA or NAIA institution will need to contact the institution and have their application reviewed, to ensure that the awarding of the ONHS Quarterback Club Scholarship does not impact their financial aid or athletic eligibility.
- **Scholarships will be awarded to qualified candidates, in numbers commensurate with the Quarterback Club's financial standing (every opportunity will be made to provide scholarships to all qualified applicants).**

Awarding of Scholarships

- All candidates receiving Olathe North Quarterback Club scholarships will be notified via email.
- After receiving the email:
 - If going to college, the candidate must enroll as a full time student in college (no less than 12 credit hours).
 - If going to a trade school, the candidate must enroll as a full time student in a trade school.
 - If going to the military, the candidate must sign an Enlistment contract with one of the branches of the military.
- Proof must be provided of enrollment or enlistment.
 - If going to college, formal proof of 1st semester enrollment (class schedule) and Student ID number at that institution must be provided to the Quarterback Club's Scholarship Committee
 - If going to trade school, a copy of the enrollment agreement, class schedule and Student ID # at that institution must be provided to the Quarterback Club's Scholarship Committee
 - If entering the military, a copy of the signed enlistment contract that includes the branch of the military, ship date, military service obligation (MSO), Military Occupational Specialty (MOS) must be provided to the Quarterback Club's Scholarship Committee
 - All of these items are due by September 30, 2026. **The candidate and/or his parents/guardians have full responsibility to provide this information to the Quarterback Club's Scholarship representative.**
- Scholarship funds will be issued by October 15, 2026. Payments could be issued directly to the scholarship office of the school, to the recipient via check, or to the recipient via Venmo based on QB Club choice and the enrollment or enlistment options. **If the criteria above is not met by November 30th of the candidate's first year out of High School, the Quarterback Club will close out the scholarship and no check will be issued. No exceptions**

Note: The Olathe North High School Quarterback Club reserves the right to review individual eligibility on a case-by-case basis.

<p>It is important to remember that the responsibility for all activities associated with application for scholarship and eligibility rest with the player and his parents/guardians. The Quarterback Club will do its best to remind each candidate of requirements and approaching deadlines, but ultimately, the candidate must take all steps necessary to ensure eligibility and scholarship receipt.</p>

Important Dates:

Senior Year High School

September 30th, 2025

- Quarterback Club dues must be paid

January 31st, 2026

- Return completed application and associated essay to the QB Club President along with GPA. (Current Seniors only)

First Year out of High School

September 30th, 2026

- Proof of enrollment or enlistment as defined above must be provided to the Quarterback Club's Scholarship Chair.

October 15th, 2026

- Scholarship funds will be issued

November 30th, 2026

- Deadline to meet the criteria for scholarship
