MARKET REPORT

Wheat futures continue to trend lower on a record US wheat crop. March '23 wheat futures ended the week little changed. Soft red winter futures were up 9 cents on the week, closing at \$7.57/bu. Hard red winter futures were up 4 cents, at \$8.73/bu. Hard red spring futures were unchanged at \$9.22/bu.

International wheat prices fell for a third consecutive month in January, by 2.5 percent, as global supplies increased with larger than previously estimated production in Australia and the Russian Federation. Read more here:

Vegetable Oils were down 2.9% from the previous month and down nearly 25% from the previous year. The continued decrease was driven by world lower prices of palm, soy, rapeseed and even sunflower seed oils.

Dairy was down 1.4% from December to January, hitting its lowest price in the last 12 months. World butter prices fell for the seventh consecutive month However, cheese prices rose slightly as market demand began to return. For more info:
