COOKING/BAKING

Cooking classes are so much more fun when you get to cook a delicious treat or meal with a group of friends. Our menus offers a variety of dishes that can include breakfast, lunch, dinner and desert items and we also offer both local dishes as well as international flavors.

POTTERY/CERAMIC ART

Pottery and ceramics classes contain a blend of projects that can include polymer, air dry and low fire clay projects. Molding clay by hand or pottery wheel is one of the most soothing projects and it is a highly recommend activity for all age groups.

SEWING/TEXTILE ARTS

Sewing/textile art projects are customized and structured based on the ages and needs of the students we are working with. Programs are designed to allow students to learn the skills of sewing but also the fundamental skills that come with it such as building confidence and self-esteem.

- Monday (10AM - 11:30AM): Grades 1 - 3
- Tuesday (10AM - 11:30AM): Grades 4 - 8
- Tuesday (1:30PM - 3PM): Teens
- All C.R.A.F.T.S students will have sewing incorporated into their curriculum.

PAINTING/DRAWING/ART

Painting workshop contain projects such as acrylic painting, watercolor painting, marble pour painting and more. Drawing workshops consist of still life and/or perspective drawing. Some projects can be building abstract art and can also include creating with natural elements such as leaves, pinecones, rocks and more.

- All C.R.A.F.T.S students will have painting, drawing & art incorporated into their curriculum.



KNITTING & CROCHET

Learning to knit and crochet is a fantastic hobby that students can take with them wherever they go. Some of the items they can create are hair accessories, toys, socks, leg warmers, clothing and more. Crochet/Knitted items are also great items for students to sell in a market setting.

- All C.R.A.F.T.S students will have knitting and/or crochet incorporated into their curriculum.



SPROUTS (AGES 3 - 5)

Imagine a preschool program where students ages 3-5 get to sew, cook, learn art/pottery, mini golf, acting/drama, learn relaxation activities & more? Welcome to Creativity Sprouts!

Our focus for this program is growth, development, creativity, and practical/fundamental skills.

The focus of our Fall 2024 Sprouts program is nature. Sprouts will have the opportunity to learn and create from the magical forest surrounding our studio and will participate in a variety of activities.





CREATIVITY ROCKS - FASHION SHOW

The Creativity Rocks fashion show is the most inspirational event of the year! Students enrolled in this program get the opportunity to design and create their own garments based on the theme of the show + they get to rock their own items down the runway in front of a crowd of hundreds of people cheering them on! CREATIVITY S.T.R.E.A.M

The Creativity Shell S.T.R.E.A.M program is a media program geared at getting students to learn technology, write about technology and read about technology. This program will focus on news topics that students will research and it will also involve students being filmed while delivering their content. Students will also learn advertising, marketing and how to design appropriate content.



MUNCHKIN MARKET

The Munchkin Market was designed to give K-12 students the opportunity to learn a craft/trade, create their product and bring their product to a live/in-person market. The Creativity Shell hosts a Spring and Winter Market each year where students get the opportunity to shine as the next generation of makers. 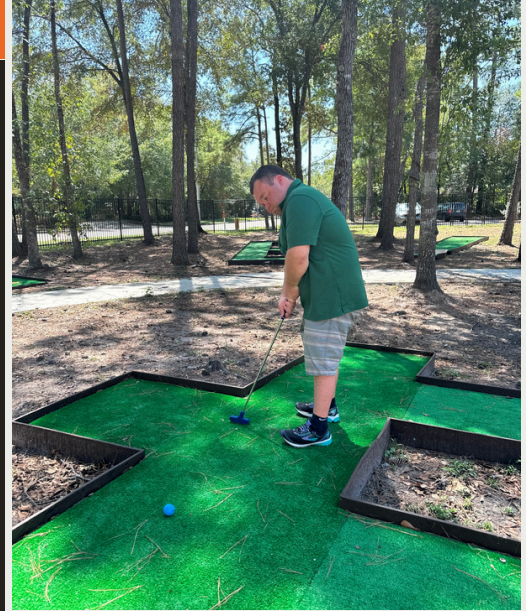
The December Munchkin Market is December 7, 2024.

POSITIVE MENTAL HEALTH

The Creativity Shell is a nonprofit organization on a mission to use creative trades to educate and inspire the next generation of makers. Our organization teaches classes such as sewing/textile arts, cooking, building and other creative trades to students in our studios, libraries, schools, ABA therapy centers, the juvenile justice system as well as shelters that rescue children from homelessness and human trafficking. All classes are designed to teach children essential life skills, practical skills and positive mental health coping skills.

Since the Creativity Shell was formed in 2015, our creative programs have been an integral ally that is fostering positive mental health in the children we are serving in the community. In 2022, our organization moved to a 20,000sq. facility in Kingwood, TX which gave us more space to create with the students in our communities. Creativity + Days were designed to give students a mental health break from the traditional school day. Students can come to the Creativity Shell where they can learn life skills and create while doing fun educational activities our organization can travel to you for some programs.
