& pH-neutral materials to complement natural coral growth*



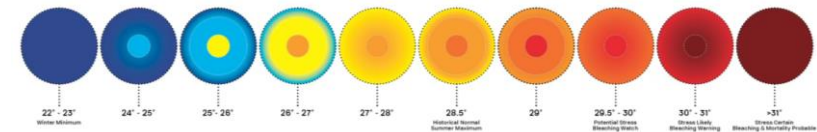


Ocean Siren

& home to the most sought-after reef fish species in the world*



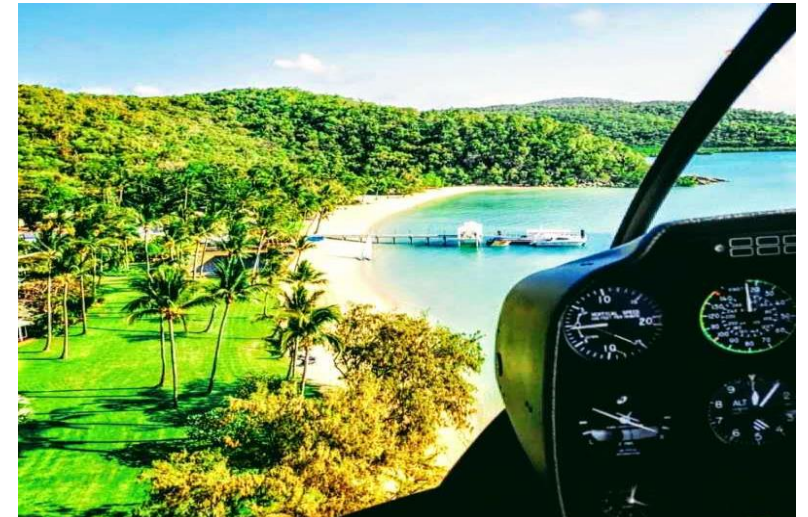
