Don't forget: If you live on the 3rd floor, please make sure you set your faucets to drip and open the cabinets underneath the faucets when the temperature goes below 30 degrees. These measures can prevent pipes from freezing. Frozen pipes can lead to broken pipes, resulting in hefty repair bills and water damage.

Recommended Drip Rate: A slight drip from the faucet is sufficient to help prevent freezing. Aim for approximately one drop every few seconds. This rate minimizes waste while ensuring continuous movement of water through the pipes. In extremely cold temperatures (closer to 0°F or below), you may want to increase the drip slightly to be on the safe side.
