A note about DISCIPLESHIP

The priest who is credited with our modern understanding of Stewardship is Msgr. Tom McGread. As a new priest in the late 1950's, he came to Kansas from Ireland. While serving in various churches in the Wichita Diocese, he began to develop a way to bring his people to Christ more fully.

He looked to the Bible, and found multiple references to being grateful, giving back, helping others, and growing in faith. Time and time again we are called to take a leap of faith—jump and know that God will catch us.

“The average person spends 25,000 days on Earth,” Msgr. McGread said a few years ago. “When we meet the Lord on the last day of our life here, we must account for how we spent those days. Did we recognize the gifts God has given us and used them for His glory, to draw others to Him and build the kingdom here on earth?” This Stewardship renewal is to help each of us give back to God for all the ways he gifts us.

GENEROSITY

We can give financially to our Church in many ways: special gifts when there is a big need, weekly donations based on our extra funds and weekly gifts based on the Biblical idea of tithing.

The 4 pillars of Discipleship

Hospitality—Who doesn't want to feel welcome? This provides the glue necessary to keep individuals and families tied closely to our Catholic faith.

Prayer—Stewardship's textbook is the Bible and its school is the Mass. There's a deep connection between the Eucharistic Celebration and Stewardship. Through prayer and living the Mass we learn to recognize, receive, accept and share God's grace and giftedness in love of God and neighbor.

Formation—A life-long journey of conversion. Prayer, education and communication are needed in the stewardship conversion process.

Service—The heart of Christian Stewardship: to serve and be served.
