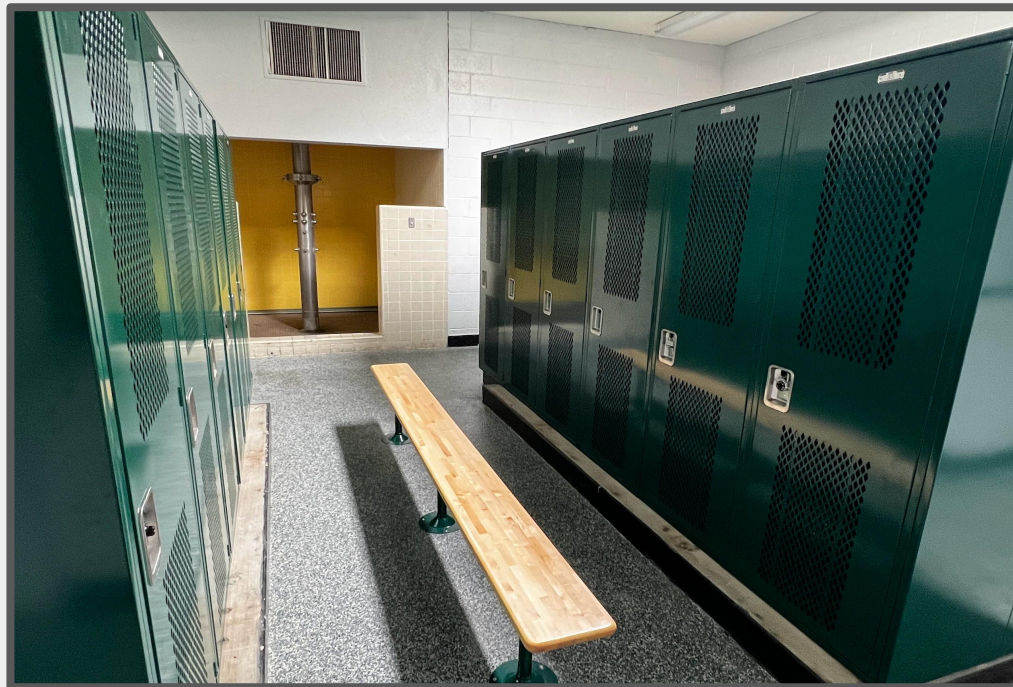
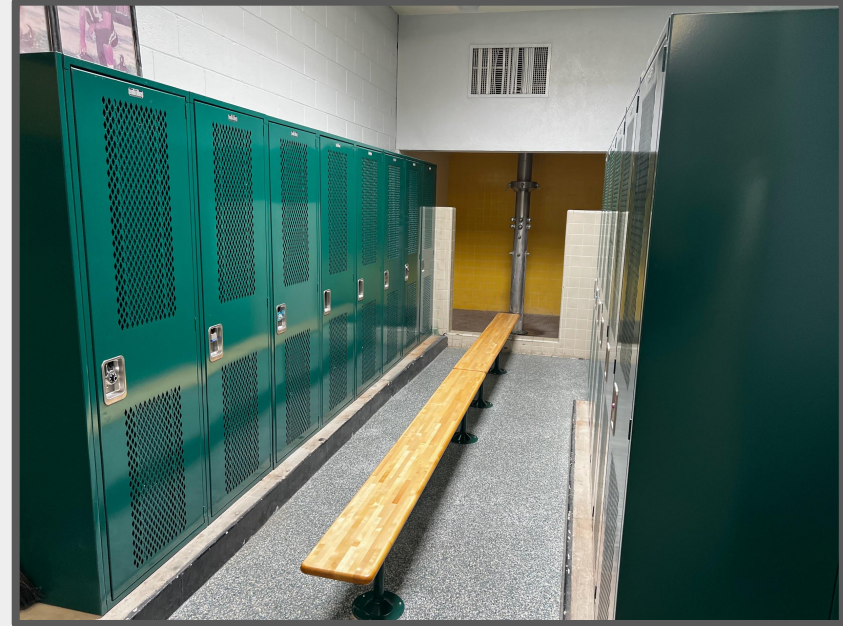

- 4.** Frosh Game Day Snack Person: Helps coordinate and deliver game day snacks to the team

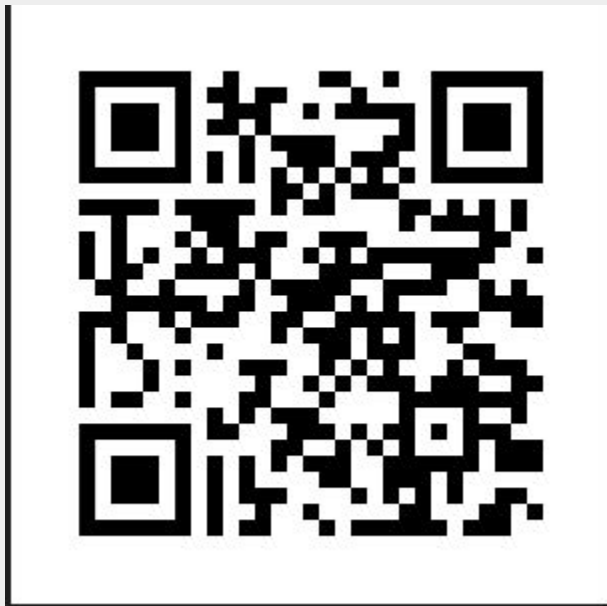
