Kristina Bartz Rizzo is currently a string teacher at Union Vale Middle School in the Arlington Central School District near Poughkeepsie, NY. She began her career in Arlington thirty years ago and has conducted orchestras at the elementary and middle school level. Mrs. Rizzo earned her B.A. in music education from the Crane School of Music, SUNY Potsdam and her M.S. in music education from Western Connecticut State University. She has also been on the staff of the Stringendo Orchestra School of the Hudson Valley where she conducts the Prelude Orchestra and works at the Summer Strings camp. She has also taught chamber music and technique classes at the NYASTA String Institute camp at Ithaca College for several years.

Mrs. Rizzo is a member of ASTA, NAFME, NYSSMA, and is an active NYSSMA adjudicator. As a violinist, she performs as principal second violinist with the Northern Dutchess Symphony Orchestra, and assistant principal second violinist with both the Woodstock Symphony Orchestra and the Greater Newburgh Symphony Orchestra. She also maintains a studio of private violin and viola students.

Mrs. Rizzo resides in the town of LaGrange, N.Y. with her husband Louis Sr. and their two sons, Louis Jr. and Matthew who also both play string instruments. Louis graduated from SUNY Purchase with a degree in cello performance and Matthew is a freshman music education and viola performance major at Ithaca College. In her free time she enjoys reading, camping, photography, and spending time with her family.

Daniel Mosher retired in 2012 from Carthage Central School District after a 33-year career as a high school band director. He has been active in all levels of the New York State School Music Association (NYSSMA) and has worked for the organization in several different capacities. In addition to serving as a county president, Mr. Mosher has acted as Area All-State Chairperson, Zone 5 Representative, Assignor of Adjudicators and 2nd Vice President and President-Elect. He served as President of the 6,000-member state music education association for 2010-2011 and he is presently working a second stint as the Assignor of Adjudicators for all NYSSMA evaluation festivals held across New York State each spring.

In 2013 Mr. Mosher conducted the inaugural New York City Area All-State High School Honors Band and has served as guest conductor for All-County Honor ensembles throughout central New York. Mr. Mosher is a NYSSMA All-State Brass, Regular Woodwind, Regular Percussion and Major Ensemble adjudicator. Mr. Mosher also serves as an adjunct instructor at Jefferson Community College, directing the Orchestra and Wind Ensemble since 2007 and he has directed the JCC Jazz Ensemble since 2016. Dan actively performs throughout the Northern New York area on trombone, trumpet and vocals as the director of the Sacci Big Band and the Tug Hill Jazz Quintet. Mr. Mosher graduated from Oswego High School and earned a Bachelor of Music degree in Music Education and Performance from Ithaca College and a Master of Music degree in Music Education from the Crane School of Music. Dan and his wife Sandy live at Pleasant Lake in the town of Champion, NY.

Robin Linaberry is now retired after 35 years of teaching music with experience at all levels from elementary to adult groups. As Director of Bands for Maine-Endwell High School, his groups earned the “Gold with Distinction” rating thirteen times. There, he also supported the development of future educators by hosting and mentoring more than thirty Student Teachers. He continues to work very frequently as an adjudicator, a music education clinician, and as a guest conductor of honor groups throughout the Northeast. In addition, Mr. Linaberry is the conductor of The Southern Tier Concert Band, a professional-level adult concert band that was awarded The American Prize in Wind Ensemble Performance: Community Division for the year 2014. He has taught for Binghamton University, Broome Community College (SUNY Broome), and Ithaca College. He was the Band Director for the well-known Signature Band & Choir Camp and spent nearly a decade as Symphonic Band Conductor and Head Director and for the internationally-known American Music Abroad tours, conducting concerts throughout ten European countries.

As a trombonist, Linaberry has performed with the Binghamton Philharmonic Orchestra, the BC Pops Orchestra, Tri-Cities Opera, the “Ice Capades”, Ringling Brothers – Barnum and Bailey Circus and a large variety of bands and brass ensembles. For nearly twenty years, Linaberry performed as an electric bassist and vocalist with numerous groups, including “Classy Brass”, which was chosen to perform for then-President William Clinton in October 2000. Mr. Linaberry is currently the NYS Chairperson for the National Band Association, and is affiliated with NafME (MENC), NYSSMA, NYSBDA, and the International Trombone Association. He has been a nominee for the GRAMMY Music Educator Award and was the first of five “Excellence In Education” honorees featured by WBNG-TV in Binghamton NY. He served as the featured Band Mentor in the MENC “Ask the Mentor” program, and is in demand as a presenter of music education workshops. As an author, his work has been featured in Music Educators Journal, SBO Magazine, The Instrumentalist and The NBA Journal.

Robin Linaberry lives in Owego, NY with his wife and best friend, Patty, an inspirational and highly-respected elementary school teacher. They are proud of their two wonderful children; their daughter, Whitney, is an activities director for a nursing home while their son, Chris, is an electrical lineman in Pittsburgh. In his free time, Robin immerses himself in carpentry, reading, writing and music composition projects. Oh, and they very freely spoil their three dogs.

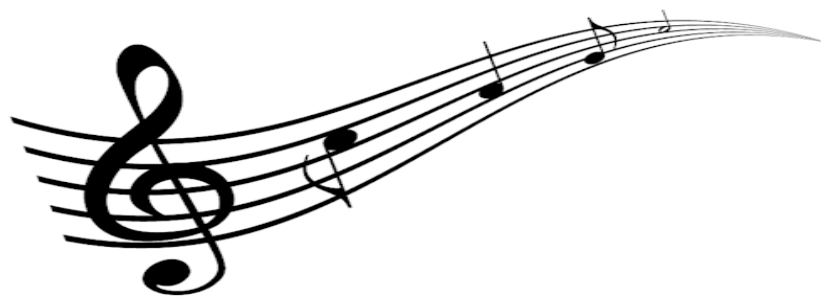
