Thank you for your interest in our pageant. This information will give you an overview of how the 2023 Little Miss Trick or Treat Pageant works and what you can expect. More details will be provided should you decide to participate. This pageant is for young ladies ages 0—11 years (must be this age the day of competition). The age divisions are as follows:

- ◆ Division I —Ages 0-2 years
- ◆ Division II—Ages 3-5 years
- ◆ Division III—Ages 6-8 years
- ◆ Division IV—Ages 9-11 years

Competition Areas

Each contestant will be judge on the following:

Formal Wear—Cupcake dress , Glitz, Sunday attire, etc. formal wear are allowed.

Personality—the contestant’s on-stage presence.

Smile—the contestant’s smile and ability to maintain a genuine, bright, and cheerful smile throughout the pageant.

Photogenic—contestant’s beauty and quality of photograph in the photo provided by the contestant.

Costume —contestant’s creativity and enthusiasm. Props are allowed.

Optional Talent Competition - contestant decide what talent to exhibit. Please note animals, weapons, sharp objects, hazardous materials are prohibited. Must be age appropriate.

Cost

Below are the fees associated with the 2023 Little Miss Trick or Treat Pageant.

EXAMPLES OF REQUIRED WARDROBE

Formal Wear—To the right are examples of formal attire acceptable for the pageant. The dress should be age appropriate. Not limited to these examples.



Costume Contest— To the right are examples (you are not limited to the examples shown). Props and face paint are allowed. Whole face coverings are not allowed, but you can wear glasses or eye coverings as shown in the example.



Crowning Attire— To the right are examples of crowning attire which should be a long gown. Dress as if you are going to be crowned. Not limited to these examples.



What if I Win?

The Little Miss Trick or Treat Pageant will crown one Supreme Queen in each age division and the division runner-ups will receive a sash and plaque. The costume competition and the talent competition will award first, second, and third place trophies. Cash prizes will be given to each Supreme Queen and first place competition winners only. The amount of the cash prizes will be determined by the number of contestants and sponsors.
