

Partner Communications System
One Touch Feature Buttons



This document will instruct you on storing popular features onto one touch buttons for quick access and ease of use. These features include:

Do Not Disturb (DND) When active, your phone will not receive calls or pages.

This feature is useful when in a meeting or working on a project.

Recall (Flash) The recall feature, often known as flash, will allow you to

access optional phone company services such as call waiting,

3-way calling, or call transfer.

Last Number (Redial) Press this button to automatically call back the number you

most recently dialed.

Conference Drop Used in conjunction with the Conference button, press DROP

to disconnect the last party you added to the call.

Privacy When active, this will prevent other users from breaking in on

your call. On occasions when you want a coworker to join

you, simply turn this feature off.

Forward The Forward button will allow you to send calls to your

extension to another extension in the office. If your

extension is administered for Remote Call Forward, you can

also forward your extension to an outside number.

To Program

NOTE: Some features require a button with a light to show active status. Avoid using the buttons directly under the LCD display for these features as they do not have lights.

- 1. At your phone, leave it hung up. Press FEATURE and then dial 0 0.
- Press the button you wish to program.
- 3. Enter the following code for the feature you wish to store:

Do Not Disturb: Press FEATURE 0.1 (requires a button with a light)

Recall (Flash): Press FEATURE 0 3
Last No. (Redial): Press FEATURE 05
Conference Drop: Press FEATURE 06

Privacy: Press FEATURE 07 (requires a button with a light)
Forward: Press FEATURE 11 (requires a button with a light)

4. To store another feature on another button, repeat from step 2. When finished programming, press FEATURE and then dial 0 0 to exit programming.
