

Oklahoma ABLE Tech, housed at Oklahoma State University in Stillwater, OK, is a federally funded program that assists Oklahomans in learning, exploring, accessing, and acquiring assistive technology (AT) and other enabling devices to gain and maintain independence. Services are provided to all Oklahomans across the state of all ages, and focus on all environments that AT or other enabling devices may assist individuals - including work, school, community, and home.

Two of ABLE Tech's core programs allow individuals to gain access to needed AT through exploring and trialing devices of potential need. This is as simple as receiving 1) a device demonstration – learning how a device works to determine if it is going to assist the user; 2) a short-term device loan – borrowing a device at no cost to use in a customary environment. Both of these activities help individuals make more informed decisions before acquiring needed AT.

To dive deeper into the technology services provided by ABLE Tech, device demonstrations give individuals the opportunity to compare the features and benefits of a particular AT device. An individual can see, touch, and try multiple devices to help in the decision-making process. ABLE Tech partners with agencies statewide to provide 12 demonstration centers: The Alzheimer's Association Tulsa Chapter, Handicapped Vehicle Services, two Area Agencies on Aging – INCOG and KEDDO, Moore Autism Center, Newby Vance Mobility Sales and Service in Guthrie, NewView OKC and Tulsa locations, OSU-Speech-Language-Hearing Clinic, Pathways Therapy Center, SoonerStart, Speech Pathway, The Bethany Children's Health Center, and United Access Mobility Auto Sales.

The Device Short-Term Loan Program provides Oklahomans the opportunity to borrow needed AT devices for up to six weeks to try before purchasing. The program is free and easy to use. Devices are shipped statewide with a return label included. ABLE Tech maintains an inventory of over 3,500 devices for individuals to trial in their home, work, or community environment: anything from smart home technology, robotic pets, iPads with apps, magnifiers, TV sound amplifiers, devices with video chats, computers, and much, much more.

For individuals looking for permanent solutions, ABLE Tech offers two programs for acquiring AT - Financial Loans and Device Reutilization.

The Financial Loan Program is available to help individuals purchase any needed AT or durable medical equipment. This includes vision/hearing/communication devices, mobility devices, daily living aids, lift chairs, home modifications such as ramps or walk-in bathtubs, and smart home technology. This program is a 5% interest rate loan with flexible lending criteria that can be repaid over a 3- to 84-month term depending on the item purchased. The program also offers a microloan program for purchases under \$2,000 that has additional credit flexibility for applicants and can be repaid over a 36-month term.

The Device Reutilization Program collects donated, gently-used equipment that is cleaned, sanitized, and then reassigned to other Oklahomans in need. Equipment includes items such as bath benches, blood pressure monitors, commodes, CPAPs/BiPAPs, gait trainers, hospital beds, knee walkers, nebulizers, patient lifts, quad canes, scooters, shower chairs, standers, walkers, and manual and power wheelchairs. ABLE Tech is proud to collaborate with Oklahoma Healthcare Authority to provide the Device Reuse Program. While this, and all programs offered by ABLE Tech serve all individuals across the state, the reuse program gives first priority to SoonerCare participants. This program also hosts a Device Exchange website where people can find, sell, or donate needed AT or other medical equipment

Want to learn more? ABLE Tech has a team of staff available to talk through needs, ideas, and solutions. Staff includes an AT Specialist, hearing AT specialist, Occupational Therapy Assistant, Speech Pathologist, and a low vision specialist. Staff will provide consultations, public training, and other educational opportunities for free. The team is readily available to assist. Save a Life Be Stroke Aware




What is a stroke? A stroke, sometimes called a brain attack, occurs when something blocks the blood supply to part of the brain or when a blood vessel in the brain bursts. In either case, parts of the brain become damaged or die. A stroke can cause lasting brain damage, long-term disability, or even death.

What are the types of stroke?

- **Ischemic Stroke:** Most strokes (87%) are ischemic strokes. An ischemic stroke happens when blood flow through the artery that supplies oxygen-rich blood to the brain becomes blocked. Blood clots often cause the blockages that lead to ischemic strokes.
- **Hemorrhagic Stroke:** A hemorrhagic stroke happens when an artery in the brain leaks blood or ruptures (breaks open). The leaked blood puts too much pressure on brain cells, which damages them. High blood pressure and aneurysms balloon-like bulges in an artery that can stretch and burst are examples of conditions that can cause a hemorrhagic stroke.
- Transient Ischemic Attack (TIA): A TIA is sometimes called a "mini-stroke." It is different from the major types of stroke because blood flow to the brain is blocked for only a short time—usually no more than 5 minutes.

What are stroke signs and symptoms?

During a stroke, every minute counts! Fast treatment can lessen the brain damage that strokes can cause. Remember BE FAST to recognize signs of stroke. If you think someone may be having a stroke, do the following simple test:



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
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
