

# Cavite LGUs roll out BOSS for FY 2021 amid COVID-19 pandemic

**TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite (PIA) -** The local government units of the cities and municipalities in the province commenced the processing of the application of new and renewal of business permits and other transactions of government services thru their Business One Stop Shop (BOSS).

As directed by the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) the BOSS established by the LGUs aims to provide frontline services and assist those who wish to apply for building permits and certificates of occupancy thereby easing bureaucratic red tape.

Starting their operations on Monday, January 4, 2021, the City Government of Trece Martires and the municipalities of Carmona, Indang, and Mendez-Núñez started facilitating these services for a period of three weeks until January 20.

Other municipalities like the Gen. Mariano Alvarez (GMA), Alfonso, Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo-Bailen started later on January 5 & 6 while the LGU Noveleta starts January 11 with applications accepted until February 15, 2021.

in this time of pandemic, the number of applications accepted are limited to as many as 150 persons per day for the BPLO (Business Permits and Licensing Office) - Trece Martires, while the satellite BOSS of the Gen. Trias only accepts up to 180 persons on a first come first served basis with the venue located at the 3rd floor of Robinson's Place in the city that is big and comfortable enough to allow the observance of physical distancing.

Meanwhile, the City Government of Imus started as early as Sunday, January 3, 2021 and requires an online assessment for the renewal of business permits with the Imus BOSS located at the Imus Sports Complex.

The City Government of Bacoor's online registration starts with the

creation of an account in the boss.bacoor.gov.ph website to be able to set an appointment.

Also, to help the Bacooreños, the LGU extended the granting of 20% discount on the payment of current Real Property Taxes (RPT) with payment accepted until March 31, 2021, and had also announced the granting of amnesty to owners of real property for payment of interests and penalties for delinquent payees of RPT for taxable year 2019 and prior years.

## Senators urged to keep an open mind on economic reforms

MANILA – The chairman of the House Committee on Constitutional Amendments on Monday urged senators to keep an open mind in the proposed amendments to certain economic provisions in the 1987 Constitution to attract foreign investments.

In a statement, Ako Bicol Rep. Alfredo Garbin Jr. said the economic amendments are long overdue, noting that it would improve the investment climate and generate much-needed jobs to counteract the economic contraction caused by the pandemic.

## DOST chief confident on FDA's say on Covid-19 vaccines

MANILA – Department of Science and Technology (DOST) Secretary Fortunato de la Peña expressed confidence in the Food and Drug Administration's (FDA) decision to approve the appropriate Covid-19 vaccine candidates in the country.

He said this amid the public's concern on Sinopharm vaccine, which was reported to cause more than 70 side effects.

"Hindi naman siguro bibigyan ng go-signal ng FDA kung hindi s'ya karapat-dapat (The FDA will not give this a go-signal if this is not worthy)," he said during the Laging Handa public briefing.

The DOST chief said vaccination would give confidence to the public that a person would not be contagious.

At least 60 percent of the population must be inoculated to achieve a herd immunity, he said.

In the same briefing, DOST Undersecretary Leah Buendia said Sinopharm is yet to decide whether it will conduct a clinical trial in the Philippines, or if it will apply for emergency use authorization (EUA).

"Hindi pa final (It is not yet final) as of the moment," she said. (PNA)



He said the introduction of the phrase "unless otherwise provided by law" in the restrictive economic provisions would give Congress the flexibility and leeway to alter the restrictions when the economic situation requires it.

"For the first time in the 33-year history of our Constitution, we in the House see that economic Cha-cha can succeed if only our counterparts in the Senate will keep an open mind on it and agree to consider relevant proposals from us and their own colleagues," he said.

Garbin allayed the fears of some senators that

agreeing to economic Cha-cha might open the Charter to wholesale amendments that could lead to extending the term of office of incumbent elective officials and lifting of the term limits.

"We are not proposing to open the basic law of the land to revisions. We want to limit ourselves to provisions relating to the economy and national patrimony. We will not touch the political sections of the Charter," he said.

Garbin stressed that Speaker Lord Allan Velasco himself has committed that the House would confine itself to amending certain economic provisions in the Charter. "The Speaker's assurance will serve as our

## Wala nang padrino sa police applicants

IPINATUTUPAD na ng Philippine National Police (PNP) ang nameless at faceless recruitment process upang tuluyan nang mabuwag ang tinaguriang influence-peddling sa organisasyon. Ang layuning ito ay upang mapigilan ang pagpasok ng mga bugok na pulis na inindorso ng kanilang padrino. Sa taas ng suweldo ngayon ng mga pulis, dapat lamang na tumbasan nila ng tamang paglilingkod sa sambayanan.

Mismong si PNP chief Gen. Guillermo Eleazar ang na-nguna sa launching ng Comprehensive Online Recruitment Encrypting System (CORES) noong nakaraang Huwebes sa PNP Multi-Purpose Center sa Camp Crame, Quezon City. Sinaksihan ito ng PNP senior police officials at mga miyembro ng academe.

Sa ilalim ng recruitment scheme, may QR Code System nang gagamitin upang matiyak na nakatago ang identity ng aplikante. Tanging ang kuwalipikasyon ng aplikante ang pag-aaralan upang matukoy kung siya ba ay kuwa-lipikado.

“Gusto ko na pong tuldukan ang bulok na sistema ng iilang aplikante na kumakapit sa matataas na opisyal ng PNP para lamang makapasok sa organisasyon. Sa gani-tong sistema, may korapsyon na kaagad eh. Iyan ang hindi ko hahayaang makapasok sa ating hanay,” sabi ni Eleazar.

May katuwiran si Eleazar dahil naging kalakaran na noon pa na ang pinaglilingkuran lamang ng mga bugok na pulis ay ang kanilang mga padrino. “We will only accept those police applicants who are most qualified and most

deserving. Only the best for the PNP. Walang mukha o pangalang lalabas habang ongoing ang application process at tanging ang credentials niya lamang ang pagba-basehan kung siya ba ay tanggap sa PNP,” sabi pa ni Eleazar.

Inihalimbawa ni Eleazar si Patrolwoman Razy Joy Alejandrino na matagumpay na nakalahok sa police force kahit na walang padrino. Kailangan pa umano nitong magtrabaho bilang tagahugas ng pinggan at janitress upang makaipon ng pera para magkaroon ng pamasaha at panggastos sa kanyang pag-aaplay.

“Isang halimbawa si Patrolwoman Alejandrino na kahit wala kang backer, maaari kang makapasok sa PNP basta’t ikaw ay masipag, matiyaga, at qualified sa aming hanay,” ani Eleazar.

But as of December 31 2020, only 1,252 cooperatives were able to submit their compliance reports and other administrative requirements in order to be considered as compliant to government standards.

As the primary agency mandated to promote the viability and growth of cooperatives in ushering social justice and economic development, the CDA is at the forefront in regulating and implementing programs to help develop cooperatives in the region.

“Ang pinakamalaking naging epekto ng pandemya sa ating mga kooperatiba ay hindi sila makipag transaksyon online kaya hindi nila nasingil ang mga liability ng members, at maraming miyembro rin ang hindi nakapag avail ng services ng cooperative.”

[The biggest effect of the pandemic to our cooperatives is that they were not able to collect the liability payment of their members because they cannot transact online. Many members were also unable to avail the services being provided by their cooperatives.]

Despite being one of the smaller national government agencies in terms of funding, Valeroso said the CDA provides technical assistance such as training and education to registered cooperatives.

They also link cooperatives to other government agencies who can provide additional funding and capital to cooperatives.

During the height of the COVID-19 pandemic, the CDA also provided Regulatory Relief to provide registered cooperatives funds for paying their balances and interests. Reporting periods for cooperatives were also extended until June 30.

“If we convert the amount since the first lockdown in March last year, in Calabarzon alone halos P1-B ang nai-contribute ng ating mga kooperatiba,” Valeroso said.

Aside from providing financial assistance to its members, some cooperatives in the region also provided personal protective equipment (PPE), cash assistance and other services to front-line workers during the pandemic.

**ARTA to gov’t agencies: Follow SEC’s lead, remove notarization requirement for business registration**

The Anti-Red Tape Authority (ARTA) called on government agencies to remove the notarization requirement for business registrations to speed up the processing of requirements.

This, after the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) implemented the reform.

The SEC did away with the mandatory requirement for notarizing the Articles of Incorporation for company registration.

In a memorandum dated 29 April 2020, the SEC said that those who wish to register new businesses can authenticate their Articles of Incorporation with a form provided by the Commission before submission instead of notarizing it.

SEC Memorandum Circular No. 16, Series of 2020 or the Guidelines on Authentication of Articles of Incorporation in Applications for Registration of New Domestic Corporations became effective on 30 April 2020.

“Bolstering ease of

doing business in the Philippines, particularly with respect to starting new corporate business, will be beneficial to the economy and may improve the business climate in the country,” the memorandum circular read.

Meanwhile, ARTA also noted the reform of the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) who is now allowing new business registrants to opt for BIR-printed receipts and invoices at the time of registration.

According to Revenue Memorandum Circular No. 117-2019, “this will allow new business taxpayers to immediately start its business operations while waiting for the printing of delivery of its receipts/invoices by the BIR-accredited printers.”

Back then, those who wished to register their new businesses had to secure an Authority to Print principal receipts/invoices before they could print their own receipts and invoices.

The memorandum circular became effective on 6 November 2019.

ARTA Secretary Jeremiah Belgica lauded the two agencies and urged others to follow its lead.

“We are calling on all other agencies with business registrations in government to follow the SEC’s example to no longer require notarization in application,” he said in a statement on Saturday.

Belgica said these reforms are seen to improve the Philippines’ score in the World Bank’s upcoming Ease of Doing Business (EODB) 2021 survey.

Last year, the country scored 62.8, placing 95th out of 190 countries, an improvement from its 57.68 score and 124th rank in 2019. (ARTA)

CALAMBA CITY, (PIA) - The Department of Health Region IV-A (DOH IV-A) recently opened a new facility for patients with kidney problems who tested positive for COVID-19.

Last May 19, Regional Director Eduardo Janairo led the opening of the Hemodialysis Center for Covid patients at the Cabuyao City Hospital in Barangay San Isidro.

With a total of 20 dialysis stations that can ammodate around 150 patients per day, the hemodialysis center is the first project established by DOH IV-A through a tripartite agreement between the city government of Cabuyao and NephroMed Asia Medical Group.

"This hemodialysis center will cater solely for patients with kidney problems who tested positive for the coronavirus. Dito, ang mga pasyenteng positibo sa

Covid virus ay tatanggapin at hindi tatanggihan na gaya ng ginagawa ng ibang hospital," Janairo said of the facility which the regional health office helped establish.

[This hemodialysis center will cater solely for patients with kidney problems who tested positive for the coronavirus. Here, patients who tested positive for the coronavirus will be accepted and not turned away like what other hospitals do.]

The region's top doctor assured that patients will receive the best services possible as the DOH IV-A facilitated the accreditation and License to Operate (LTO) for this project.

Aware of the treatment costs, Janairo assured that patients who will undergo dialysis need not worry about paying for their treatment.

"Sasagutin ng PhilHealth ang gastos at kung may kulang pa ay pupunan ito ng regional office through

the medical assistance for indigents program. Kaya walang dahilan upang hindi makapagpagamot ang mga pasyenteng nangangailangan ng dialysis treatment,"


[PhilHealth will shoulder the costs, while the regional office will pay for the remaining costs through the medical assistance for indigents program. There is no longer a reason for patients not to get their dialysis treatment.]

Aside from the treatment costs, Janairo added that DOH will also assist in logistics augmentation, including the provision of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) when needed. (PB/DOH 4-A)
