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CAVITE, RIZAL, BULACAN UNDER ALERT LEVEL 3 ON JAN. 5-15

The provinces of Bulacan, Cavite, and Rizal will shift to a stricter Alert Level 3 from January 5 to 15 due to a surge in coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19) cases, possibly spiked by the Omicron variant, Malacañang announced recently

Acting Presidential Spokesperson, Cabinet Secretary Karlo Nograles, said the decision was reached by the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) in a meeting on Monday.

“Due to a sharp increase of Covid-19 cases in the particular localities, the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) approved yesterday, Jan. 3, 2022, the recommendation of its sub-Technical Working Group on Data Analytics to escalate Bulacan, Cavite, and Rizal to Alert Level 3. This shall take effect from Jan. 5, 2022 until Jan. 15, 2022,” he said.

On Dec. 31, 2021, the IATF raised Metro Manila to Alert Level 3 until January 15.

Nograles said the current hospital care utilization rate is “not as high.”

“Hindi sumipa ng ganong kataas iyong admissions natin sa hospital (Our admissions in hospitals did not increase that much). ICU is not bad, but the cases are rising,” he said.

The Department of Health (DOH) earlier said there was a high possibility of local transmission of the Omicron variant of Covid-19 after the country tallied more than 4,000 new infections for the second straight day.

As of January 3, the DOH recorded 4,084 new Covid-19 cases, bringing the country's caseload to (continued on page 4)

Batangas, Cavite local execs thank Cayetano for 'big help' from Sari-saring Pag-asa

Local officials in Batangas and Cavite expressed their gratitude to former House Speaker Alan Peter Cayetano for his Sari-saring Pag-asa financial aid program for small businesses, with more than a thousand microentrepreneurs in the two provinces receiving cash assistance from the program on recently.

Sari-saring Pag-asa, in partnership with the social welfare department's Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations relief program, provided P3,500 each in cash aid each to 1,490 small business owners in Batangas and Cavite on December 28, 2021.

Mayor Faye Endaya-Barretto of Cuenca, Batangas thanked Cayetano for extending help not just to small business owners in her town but throughout the province's 2nd congressional district, adding that the people in that district especially needed the aid due to the back-to-back crises they faced in the last year and a half.

“Lahat po kasi kami halos nakapalibot po sa Taal Volcano, so hindi po iisa lamang ang naging unos na dumaaan po sa aming bayan, kundi po mayroon pong pagputok ng bulkan at ang pandemic,” Barretto said.

“So napakalaking tulong po ng Sari-saring Pag-asa para po sa ating mga kababayan, hindi lang po dito sa Cuenca, kundi sa

buong ikalawang distrito po ng Batangas,” the mayor added.

(All of our towns are in the vicinity of Taal Volcano, so our townsfolk didn't go through just one crisis, because there was the eruption as well as the pandemic. So Sari-saring Pag-asa is a big help to our people, not just in Cuenca, but in the whole second district of Batangas.)

Magallanes, Cavite Vice Mayor Renato Dimapilis also thanked Cayetano for helping store owners in his area get back on their feet.

“Ito ay isang magandang programa na ang ating butihing Senator Alan Peter Cayetano ay magbibigay ng tulong puhunan sa mga may

tindahan dito sa Magallanes,” Dimapilis said.

(This is a very good program of our good Senator Alan Peter Cayetano, in order to provide additional capital to our store owners in Magallanes.)

Magallanes Municipal Councilor Jesus Antazo pointed out that despite his town's relative remoteness compared to the rest of Cavite, the office of the former speaker still chose his constituents to receive aid from Sari-saring Pag-asa.

protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, Section 2 (b) of Executive Order No. 168 (s.2014) mandates the

Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF) to prevent and/or minimize the entry of suspected or confirmed patients with emerging infectious diseases

into the country;

WHEREAS, on September 10, 2020, the President issued Proclamation No. 1218

(s.2021) further extending the period of the State of Calamity throughout the Philippines until

September 12, 2021, unless earlier lifted or extended as circumstances may warrant;

WHEREAS, the Department of Health (DOH), the University of the

Philippines-Philippine Genome Center (UP-PGC), and the University of the Philippines-National

Institutes of Health (UP-NIH) biosurveillance have detected B.1.1.7 (Alpha), B.1.351 (Beta), P.1

(Gamma), B.1.617 (Delta), and B.1.1.529 (Omicron) variants of SARS-CoV-2 in the Philippines.

WHEREAS, the IATF approved the shift in the policy of classifying Provinces, Highly

Urbanized Cities (HUCs), and Independent Component Cities (ICC) for purposes of community

quarantine and adopted the Alert Levels System for identified pilot areas of implementation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that the IATF

approves the recommendation of the sub-Technical Working Group on Data Analytics in

escalating Bulacan, Cavite, and Rizal to Alert Level 3 from 05 January 2022, until 15 January

2022.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Chairperson and the Co-Chairperson shall be duly

authorized to sign this Resolution for and on behalf of the Inter-Agency Task Force.

1. Presbyopia – Humihina ang pag-focus ng ating mata sa malalapit na bagay. Normal lang ito. Kumunsulta sa isang optometrist para magpasukat ng salamin.

2. Eye bags – Para mabawasan ang eye bags, subukang maghilamos ng malamig na tubig sa umaga. Puwede rin gumamit ng basang cotton balls na nilubog sa yelo o pipinong pinalamig. Ipatong ito sa mata ng 15 minuto at mababawasan ang pamamaga ng mata. Ang isa pang home remedy ay ang paggamit ng teabag (bag ng tsa) na ipinapatong sa mata. Ang teabag ay may tannin na lumilinis at nagpapa-firm ng balat.

3. Dry eyes – Pangkaraniwang sakit ito ng may edad 60 pataas kung saan nababawasan ang paggawa ng luha. Ang solusyon dito ay ang madalas na pagpatak ng artificial tears na mabibili sa botika. Kung gustong makatipid, puwedeng magtimpla ng sariling “luha”. Maghalo ng kati-ting na asin at isang onsang distilled water. Ihalo maigi at gamitin itong pangpatak sa mata. Bumili na lang ng drop-per.

4. Katarata – Kapag malabo ang salamin ng kotse ay mahihirapan kang magmaneho. Ganito rin ang nangyayari sa katarata kung saan lumalabo ang lente ng mata. Ang sanhi ng katarata ay ang matinding araw, pag-edad, dia-betes at paninigarilyo. Hanggang ngayon ay walang pang-patak para malunasan ang katarata. 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Knowledge Channel, DOST partner to bring STEM closer to public

Soon, materials from the Department of Science and Technology - Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI) will be shown on Knowledge Channel's platforms as the two recently signed a partnership, an executive of SEI said on Thursday.

"It (partnership) will make STEM (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics) educational resources more accessible to the learners through the various media channels used by Knowledge Channel in distributing content for basic education," SEI chief science research specialist, Ruby Cristobal, told the Philippine News Agency (PNA).

She said the partnership was signed on November 29, but the turnover of the first batch of materials will be slated in the coming days.

Among the initial video programs to be turned over are "Radyo Eskwela" and "TuklaSiyensya".

"Radyo Eskwela" is for elementary students and has 20 episodes, while "TuklaSyensya" has 15 video presentations for high school students.

"Our STEM modules and educational resources will be shown in their (Knowledge Channel) programs and distributed for free in their beneficiary schools," Cristobal said.

This partnership will help contribute to the SEI's goal of promoting STEM careers and enhancing interest in mathematics and science.

It also aims to improve the students' performance in these areas, she said.

According to SEI, Knowledge Channel develops, acquires, and distributes Department of Education K-12 curriculum-based multimedia learning resources on-air, online, and offline to supplement the effective and relevant delivery of basic education.

Earlier, Knowledge Channel also partnered with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) for "Wikaharian", an animated series of lessons for Grade 1 students.

"Wikaharian" is a daily lesson about reading. The animated series is in English and Filipino, showcasing lessons that would help instill Filipino values and traditions. (PNA)

Cayetano urges gov't to rationalize use of National Budget for crises, other issues

Former House Speaker Alan Peter Cayetano on Friday said the government must rationalize the utilization of the National Budget so that it is able to address crises and other issues comprehensively and completely without being sidetracked every time a new crisis arises.

In a media interview on January 7, 2022, Cayetano said the good news is the government has the money to address disasters, pandemics, and the needs of all sectors.

"Hindi problema ang pera. There's P80 billion with DSWD (Department of Social Welfare and Development), DOLE (Department of Labor and Employment), DTI (Department of Trade and Industry), and DOTr (Department of Transportation)," he said.

The problem, he said, is that the government needs to be more organized and more focused in its handling of crises.

Cayetano said this can be seen in how disasters have been handled in the last few years.

"Medyo magaling na tayo sa relief but medyo mabagal talaga tayo sa rehabilitation. In fact 'pag may nangyaring bagong kalamidad, nakakalimutan na natin y'ung dati," he said.

(We do well when it comes to disaster relief but we are slow when it comes to rehabilitation. In fact if a new calamity arises, we forget the previous ones.)

Cayetano said this happened when typhoon Yolanda hit the country in November 2013, just a month after a 7.2 magnitude earthquake hit Bohol.

"That happened to Bohol nung malaki ang damage ng lindol before tapos nagka-Yolanda. Buti na lang the Boholanos said unahin nyo ang Yolanda kasi sila maraming namatay, kami damage lang. Pero hindi na nabalikan y'ung iba," he said.

(There was huge damage in Bohol due to the earthquake, and then Yolanda hit. It was a good thing the Boholanos said the victims of Yolanda should be prioritized because there were many deaths there. But what happened was the government was not able to go back to them anymore," he said.

"I hope this doesn't happen to the victims of typhoon Odette," he added.

Cayetano said this is one reason he and President Duterte made a campaign promise to create a Department of Disaster Resilience.

hab," he said.

(We are thankful to the NDRRMC and of course the local governments, but really we need a single agency because we are hit by may typhoons, earthquakes, volcanic eruptions, and man-made disasters like fires. We need a department that will do nothing but disaster relief and rehabilitation.)

Pandemic response

Cayetano said the COVID-19 pandemic also requires a more focused approach from the government, particularly when it comes to providing financial assistance.

"Nagtatrabaho naman talaga ang gobyerno, lalo na y'ung local government, o IATF, pero y'ung mindset kasi parang matatapos na ang pandemic, may bakuna na, may gamot na, eh all the doctors have been telling us, we have to live with COVID, hindi basta mawawala ito," Cayetano said.

(The government is working hard, especially local government units [LGUs] and the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases [IATF], but the mindset that the pandemic will end, that there are vaccines and medicines for it anyway, cannot justify our current mindset. Doctors have said that we have to live with COVID.)

"We cannot innovate, we cannot adapt kung ang parati nating iniisip 'matatapos na' (if our mindset is that the pandemic is about to end)," he added.

Cayetano also said two years into the pandemic, the government is still finding it difficult to make sure affected Filipinos receive aid.

"Ang good news, between DSWD, DOLE, DOTr, at DTI, may P80 billion na ayuda. Ang bad news, napakaliit ng P80 billion," he said.

(The good news, between the Department of Social Welfare and Development [DSWD], Department of Labor and Employment [DOLE], Department of Transportation [DOTr], and the Department of Trade and Industry [DTI] there is P80 billion in financial aid. The bad news is P80 billion is too small an amount.)

"So kung magla-lockdown tayo, mangangapa na naman tayo kung saan tayo kukuha, so napaka-importante na sa bawat galaw natin, we try to predict the unpredictable," he added.

(If we face lockdown again, we'll have difficulty finding enough funds again. It's important that we be prepared and predict the unpredictable.)

Cayetano said providing financial aid directly to all Filipino families is the simpler and more efficient way to distribute financial aid, especially at a time when the Philippines may see more stringent lockdowns in light of the Omicron variant.

He also said the targeted approach will not work because the funds are lodged in different departments and agencies.

"The most simple way is tulad sa Bayanihan 1. Just give it per family, ibigay niyo sa LGU, at lahat bigyan niyo na. So y'ung targeted approach na per department, it really doesn't work, so I hope ma-speed up talaga para hindi naman mawalan ng pag-asa ang ating mga kababayan," Cayetano said.

(The most simple way is the one adapted by Bayanihan 1. Just give the aid to every family through the LGUs. The targeted approach in which every department distributes its own aid doesn't work, so I hope this can be speeded up so that our people do not lose hope.)

DOH releases home quarantine guidelines amid soaring infections

MANILA – The Department of Health (DOH) on Friday released a set of home quarantine guidelines for individuals positive who have been infected with coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19) to keep hospitals from being congested as new infections continue to rise.

Health Undersecretary Maria Rosario Vergeire, in a Palace briefing, said individuals infected with Covid-19 and have symptoms may undergo home quarantine if they have their own room and bathroom with proper ventilation and have oversight or medical supervision.

She noted that all household members of Covid-positive individuals are considered close contacts and may also undergo home quarantine if they are asymptomatic, are not members of the vulnerable population, and are not mixed with posi-

tive and symptomatic individuals.

She added they must observe minimum public health standards – proper wearing of masks, social distancing, and proper hand washing.

"Para naman po sa mga indibidwal na nag-a-isolate at nakakaranas ng mild to moderate symptoms, i-maximize ang paggamit ng

telemedicine services. Iwas transmission at iwas sana rin ito sa pagpuno ng ating mga ospital (To all who are in home isolation with mild to moderate symptoms,

maximize the use of telemedicine services. Avoid transmission and avoid hospital congestion)," she said.

Citing the guidelines, Vergeire emphasized asymptomatic individuals or those who have mild to moderate symptoms must isolate for 10 days or at the advice of their doctor regardless of vaccination status.

Meantime, severe and critical patients must isolate for 21 days or at the advice of their doctor.

"(The) government has shortened the isolation period of fully vaccinated medical front-liners in consideration of hospitals' capacity," Vergeire said.

Healthcare workers who are asymptomatic or have mild to moderate symptoms must isolate for five days while their close contacts are not required to quarantine. (PNA)

The DOH also reported 497 more people getting better, bringing total recoveries to 2,779,241 while 16 more fatalities pushed the death toll to 51,586.

The positivity rate was 20.7 percent, about four times the World Health Organization's benchmark of below 5 percent to indicate that coronavirus transmission is under control.

Under Alert Level 3, a 30 percent indoor venue capacity and 50 percent outdoor venue capacity will be allowed for some activities, provided employees are fully

vaccinated.

However, face-to-face or in-person classes for basic education; contact sports, except those conducted under the bubble-type setup; funfairs/carnivals and kid amusement industries; venues with live voice or wind instrument performers and audiences; casinos, horse racing, cockfighting and operation of cockpits, lottery and betting shops, and other gaming establishments; and gatherings in residences with individuals not belonging to the same household will be prohibited. New infections soar to 33K; another 3K beat Covid-19

MANILA – The number of fresh coronavirus infections in the country soared to 33,169, the highest since the start of the pandemic in March 2020, the Department of Health (DOH) reported on Monday.

In its latest Covid-19 bulletin, the agency said this brought the total active case tally to 157,526, out of a total of 2,998,530 infections since the start of the pandemic.

Monday's figure of new cases surpassed Sunday's 28,707.

Another 3,725 recoveries were also recorded, accounting for 93 percent of the total number of confirmed infections.

Out of the active cases, 147,912 are mild, 2,858 are moderate, 4,994 are asymptomatic, 1,461 are severe, and 301 are critical.

"Of the 33,169 reported cases today, 32,972 (99 percent) occurred within the recent 14 days – Dec. 28, 2021 to Jan. 10, 2022," the DOH reported.

The regions with the most cases in the recent two weeks were the National Capital Region (NCR) with

18,535 or 56 percent of new infections; Calabarzon, 7,443 or 23 percent; and Central Luzon, 3,403 or 10 percent.

The death toll has reached 52,293 with 145 new deaths, representing 1.76 percent of overall cases.

"Of the 145 deaths, 3 occurred in November 2021 (2 percent), 18 in October 2021 (12 percent), 52 in September 2021 (36 percent), 22 in August 2021 (15 percent), 24 in July 2021 (17 percent), 13 in June 2021 (9 percent), 5 in May 2021 (3 percent), 1 in March 2021 (1 percent), 1 in February 2021 (1 percent), and 6 in January 2021 (4 percent). Deaths were from and Region 11 (145 or 100 percent) due to the late encoding of death information to COVIDKaya," the DOH said.

COVIDKaya is a digital application used by healthcare workers to collect and share data about Covid-19 cases.

According to the January 8 data, about 46 percent of 73,234 who were tested turned out positive for Covid-19.

"Eighty-six duplicates

were removed from the total case count as 73 of these are recoveries and two are deaths," the DOH said.

Meanwhile, 124 cases previously tagged as recoveries were reclassified as deaths after validation.

All laboratories were operational on January 8 but 10 were not able to submit their data to the Covid-19 Document Repository System.

The DOH said the 14 laboratories contribute, on average, 6.2 percent of samples tested, and 6.3 per-

cent among positive individuals based on data in the past 14 days.

To date, 38 percent of 3,400 intensive care unit (ICU) beds, 41 percent of 19,500 isolation beds, 41 percent of 13,500 ward beds, and 17 percent of 2,900 ventilators are used by patients with Covid-19 nationwide.

Meanwhile, 52 percent of 1,100 ICU beds, 54 percent of 4,700 isolation beds, 67 percent of 4,800 ward beds, and 25 percent of 1,000 ventilators dedicated to patients with Covid-19 are in use in the NCR. (PNA)

SC implements shifting, WFH arrangements amid rise in cases

MANILA – The Supreme Court (SC) on Friday announced a reduced on-site work capacity starting January 10.

In a memorandum, the high court said the reduction and modified work shifts are needed because of "the recent massive infection of personnel" which "may have been brought about by the reported highly transmissible Omicron variant".

Under the latest scheme eyed to minimize close physical contact, one third of SC's work force shall be required to physically report on Mondays and Tuesdays, another third on Wednesdays and Thursdays, and the remaining third on Fridays and Saturdays.

Those not on-site are under work-from-home (WFH) arrangement.

Personal filing of initiatory pleadings before the SC was likewise ordered "discontinued until further orders".

The SC earlier extended work suspension in its offices until Saturday to allow massive antigen testing of its employees and contact tracing.

Personnel of the Office of the Bar Chair and Office of



the Bar Confidant involved in the 2020/2021 Bar examination on January 23 and 25 and personnel of the Judicial Records Office involved in e-filing are still required to report on-site, the court said. (PNA)
