CAVITE CITY, (PIA) – The Cavite City government recently coordinated with the officials of the Corregidor Foundation, Inc. for the rehabilitation of the historic Corregidor Island.

A Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) was signed during the meeting by the city government headed by Mayor Denver Chua, City Administrator Abraham Urubio together with Ms. Cynthia Carrion, Chairperson of the Corregidor Foundation, Inc., and Ms. Rowena Bautista, Officer-in-Charge (OIC) Department Manager.

Ha also says that for a long time, the city government had not utilized the historic site and did not participate in its development.

“With the cooperation of Councilor Nash Aguas, Chair, Committee on Tourism, our goal is to make

tourism shine in our city,” the mayor said.

Corregidor Island is 37 kilometers or 19.9784 nautical miles off the shores of Cavite city proper in PN, Samonte Park, and places second to the most visited tourist destinations in the province despite its geographical location having to travel by ferry boat. 3. Palitan ng mas maliit ang plato, at kumuha ng kaya lang ngayain. Bagalan ang pagkain para mas makaramdan ng pagkabusog.

4. Bago mag-umpisa kumain, puwede ka munang uminom ng 1 basong tubig para mabusog ka ng kaunti. Puwede ding uminom ng clear soup. Kapag umiinom tayo ng mga likido, medyo nakukumbinsi natin ang ating utak na nabubusog na tayo.

5. Magbawas sa pagkain ng kanin. Kung dati at 2 cups ng kanin ang kinakain, gawin na lang 1 cup rice.

6. Huling payo. Dahan-dahanin lang ang pagpapapayat. Huwag gutumin ang sarili. Kumain ng pakonti-konti sa buong araw, tulad ng mansanas, saging o pandesal, para laging may lamang ang inyong tiyan. Good luck.

CARE AND GUIDELINES FOR PETS BEFORE AND AFTER SURGERY

1. Neutering (KAPON) is a surgical procedure wherein the uterus is removed from the female pet and the testicles are removed for the male pet to prevent them from unwanted reproduction.

2. A neutered pet will not be capable of reproduction; the male pets may still have the desire to mate due to their memory of the behavior, still there is possibility that seven (7) days after the procedure the male pets may still get female pets pregnant due to their reserved sperm.

3. Your pets will undergo anesthesia, after the operation let it rest to recover. Long-acting pain reliever and antibiotics will be administered after the surgery.

4. Pets should not be given food and water after the operation, allow 5-6 hours to pass before giving light to moderate amount of food and water.

5. Your pet may display inactivity for two (2) days after the operation.

6. Pets should not be bathe for seven (7) days after the operation.

7. Do not let your pet jump, run or play with other pets for seven (7) days. Avoid letting them lick, bite or play with their wound. Use e-collar to be safe.

8. Be sure to give the prescribed medication to avoid any infection.

9. Kindly place E-collar on your pet after surgery.

10. If there's unusual bleeding, wound infection, lethargy, loss of appetite/drinking, or vomiting, please bring to the nearest vet or immediately contact City Vet Office (046-850-7004.)

Kahapon lamang, hinostage si dating senador Leila de Lima ng tatlong Abu Sayyaf detainees habang nakakulong sa Camp Crame custodial center. Napatay ang tatlong Sayyaf ng mga pulis. Patuloy na nag-iimbestiga ang mga pulis sa pagpatay kay Lapid. Nag-offer naman ng P500,000 si DILG secretary Benhur Abalos sa sinumang makapagsusuplong sa mga suspects.

PBBM closely monitoring POGO issue; tasks PNP to take action

MANILA -- President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. is closely watching the Philippine offshore gaming operators (POGO) in the country and expects the police to act on untoward incidents involving its operations, Office of the Press Secretary and Officer-in-Charge Undersecretary Cheloy Velicaria-Garafil said on Wednesday, October 12, 2022.



During a press briefing in Malacañang, Garafil was asked if there's a directive from Marcos regarding the POGO industry considering the controversies surrounding its operations.

"Of course, the President is closely monitoring this. And as far as the President is concerned, ang PNP po ang in-charge dito sa usapin na ito," Garafil said.

The Palace official also welcomed the statement from the Chinese Embassy clarifying that the Philippines was not blacklisted as a destination for Chinese tourists.

According to the embassy, the report of the tourist blacklist is misinformation.

"Nakita na natin iyong paglilinaw nga ng Chinese Embassy, at nagpost na rin sila ng official statement nila sa kanilang

social media accounts. And we share the sentiment of the Chinese Embassy in the Philippines that tourism is an important facet to our relation-

ship," Garafil said. "And we look forward to continuing with that relationship as we continuously welcome our friends from China, and we anticipate more of them to come in the months and years ahead," she added.

The Marcos administration sees the tourism industry as a significant income generator for the country as it reopens following the imposition of restrictions due to the coronavirus pandemic.

Pres Marcos to grace DOST's Balik Scientists convention

MANILA, (PIA) -- President Ferdinand "Bongbong" Marcos Jr. on Friday will grace the Balik Scientists Program (BSP) Convention in Pasay City, and will personally witness a number of innovations by Filipinos scientists that seek to address problems the country is facing.

According to the Department of Science and Technology (DOST), the BSP Convention, which will also be made available online, will provide updates on recent technologies, research studies, and capacity-building initiatives that revolve around different sectors such as health, agriculture, aquatic, industry, and energy.

The DOST will also present its plans for the BSP, with the goal of increasing public awareness on how Balik Scientists have contributed to addressing national concerns.

A report by the Philippine News Agency said that among the 12 Balik Scientist presenters is Engr.



Syrus Gomari, who will share about his project that aims to address traffic. "The solutions in the past 40 years have not been scalable or proactive. The benefit we have today is the widespread adoption of all sorts of technology," Gomari said.

He said he is testing various artificial intelligence (AI) tools to help two pilot cities in Manila. "If proven that these solutions work in the local context, I am confident that they will work all over the Philippines and beyond. Research should not just be limited to academic institutions, considering the numerous problems that already exist, we should push for applied research directly in partner-

ship with the direct beneficiaries," Gomari said.

Another presenter, Dr. Thaddeus Carvajal, will showcase studies on dengue. "Dengue fever is a rapidly emerging arthropod-borne viral disease worldwide, especially in the Philippines. The dynamics of the disease are affected through a comprehensive combination of factors that can be used appropriately in vector control measures," Carvajal said.

Philippine-based studies focusing on the biological and ecological aspects of dengue disease transmission will be presented. Carvajal said the different biological control approaches and their effectiveness in reducing disease transmission through a systematic review will also be featured.

The DOST said that to date, the BSP has already produced 603 Balik Scientists. Established in 1975, the BSP aims to encourage Filipino scientists to return to the Philippines and share their expertise.

The DOST said technical discussions are in the pipeline to create more opportunities to build a stronger scientific community.

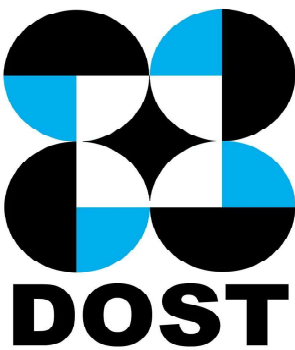

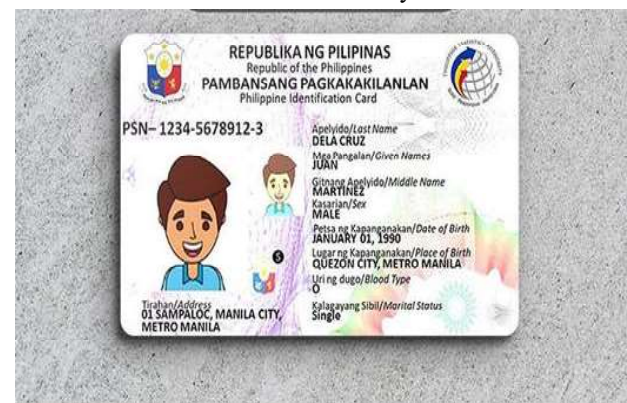
