

## SSS RACE campaign probes delinquent entrepreneurs in Cavite

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite (PIA) – The Social Security System rolled out its Run After Contribution Evaders (RACE) Campaign in the municipality of Naic this October to intensify the campaign correcting errant business owners/employers.

The activity was headed by SSS Luzon South 1 Division Acting Head Edwin S. Igharas, and SSS Rosario Branch Head Eva E. Tomenio wherein ten delinquent establishments were visited and were issued written orders to which they must respond within fifteen (15) days to settle the obligations due.

According to SSS records, more than P 2M in obligations due are expected to be paid by these establish-



ments.

This is a non-compliance under the Social Security Act of 2018 (RA 11199)

which will affect the benefits of 139 employees. The employer may also be prosecuted if they would not settle the obligation on the

said date.

4. Mag-ingat sa sports. Puwedeng magsuot ng espesyal na protection eyeglasses, na nabibili sa mga sports shops. Gawa ito sa polycarbonate, isang uri ng matigas na plastic. Nakita mo ba ang mga NBA players na may suot ng salamin? Ito'y para protektahan ang kanilang mata.

5. Maghugas maigi ng kamay. Para makaiwas sa sore eyes, maghugas palagi ng kamay. Huwag ding basta-bastang magkamot o punasan ang mata. Gumamit ng panyo o tissue.

6. Ipahinga ang mata. Puwede mong ipikit ang mata habang ika'y nakasakay sa kotse o kaya ay may kinakausap sa telepono. Matulog din ng 7-8 oras.

7. Mag-hugas ng mata sa paggising at bago matulog. Gumamit lang ng malinis na tubig.

8. Ipa-check ang iyong blood sugar. Kung ika'y may diabetes, malaki ang tsansang magkaroon ng diabetic eye disease. Siguraduhin mababa ang iyong blood sugar sa pamamagitan ng ehersisyo at gamot.

9. Umiwas sa nakasisilaw na bagay. Huwag tumitig sa araw at maliwanag na ilaw. Ito ang pinakamahalagang payo para hindi masira ang ating mata. Subukan ding diliman ang ating computer screen at telebisyon para hindi tayo masilaw. Good luck po!

## DOH 4A nagbabala laban sa food-borne diseases ngayong Undas 2022

LUNGSOD NG CALAMBA (PIA) – Pinag-iingat ng Department of Health - Center for Health Development CALABARZON ang publiko sa mga food-borne disease at food poisoning para sa nalalapit na Undas o All Saints' Day sa ika-1 ng Nobyembre.

Sa opisyal na pahayag ng DOH Calabarzon, ipinaalala ni Infectious Disease Cluster Head, Dr. Evamarie V. Torio na ugaliing maghugas ng kamay bago humawak at maghanda ng pagkain.

Mahalaga rin aniyang ihiwalay ang hilaw na karne, manok, at seafood mula sa iba pang mga pagkain; lutuin nang lubusan ang pagkain, lalo na ang karne, manok, itlog, at seafood; panatilihin din ang mga pagkain sa ligtas na temperatura, huwag iwanan ang nilutong pagkain sa temperatura ng silid nang higit sa 2 oras; at laging gumamit ng malinis na tubig at mga hilaw na materyales.

Ang Food-borne Diseases (pagkalason sa pagkain) ay mga sakit na dulot ng mga infectious agents (bacteria, viruses, parasites) at bacteria, viruses, parasites (chemicals, animal and plant toxins).

"Oras na panis na ang pagkain, posibleng kontaminado na ito ng mga microorganism kabilang na ang Staphylococcus Aureus with an incubation period of as fast as 30 minutes, maari din pong Salmonella at E. coli," saad ni Dr. Torio.

Ayon din sa DOH, kung hinihinala na nangyari ang food poisoning ay humingi agad ng atensyong medical lalo't kung patuloy ang mga sintomas. Ang mga sintomas ng pagkalason sa pagkain ay kinabibilangan ng pagduduwal, pagsusuka, pananakit ng tiyan, at karamihan ay dumaranas ng pagtatae.

Gayunman, nagpapaalala pa din ang DOH na patuloy pa din ang pandemya, makabubuting huwag magtagal sa mga sementeryo.

"Sa halip na magdala ng lutong pagkain, maaari magdala ng magaan na meryenda tulad ng tinapay, biskwit, malinis na inuming tubig, at mga prutas na may balat tulad ng saging, dalandan, mansanas, at lansones," dagdag pa ni Dr. Torio. (MBIL/PIA4A may ulat mula sa DOH CALABARZON)

## DHSUD, sectoral groups tackle inclusive PBBM housing program

MANILA – Department of Human Settlement and Urban Development (DHSUD) Undersecretary Garry De Guzman met leaders of sectoral groups, including urban poor, to tackle housing projects implementations, highlighting the inclusivity of President Ferdinand R. Marcos' Pambansang Pabahay para sa Pilipino: Zero ISF 2028 Program.

De Guzman, officer-in-charge of the DHSUD, led the dialogue with the urban poor group Kalipunan ng Masang Pilipino (KAMPIL), Pilipino Drivers Transport Academy Philippines (PDTap), and Philippine Association of Detective and Protective Agency Operators (PADPAO) on Oct. 18.

"This engagement with sectoral groups underscores the inclusivity of the administration's housing program. That every Filipino family can take part in the

Pambansang Pabahay Program," he said in a news release on Thursday.

The dialogue was focused on the policy formulation on how the DHSUD can help the members of the groups in their quest for their dream homes.

In a consultative meeting at the DHSUD Central Office, De Guzman, assisted by Assistant Secretary-designate Sharon Faith Paquiz, addressed queries regarding the program raised by the leaders of KAMPIL, PDTap and PADPAO.

He also acknowledged the inputs from the sectoral groups, even as he expressed DHSUD's readiness to assist them in capacitating their group on estate management and payment collection efficiency.

Under the program, sectoral groups may tie-up with host local government units in managing the housing units for their members. "We also see your

groups as one of the key partners in providing affordable homes to middle-income and low-income earners," De Guzman said after learning that sectoral groups have established business relationships with local developers.

Orlando Marquez, PDTAP National President, expressed his support to the housing program citing the benefit for their homeless members which include jeepney, bus, taxi, van, and tricycle drivers.

Meanwhile, the PADPAO team requested technical assistance from DHSUD to access development loans from the Development Bank of the Philippines which has already entered into an MOU with DHSUD in support of the housing program.

Speaking for low-income earners and informal settler families in Teresa, Rizal province, KAMPIL Chairperson Jervino Maglunob assured DHSUD

that they are more than willing to participate and ready to implement the project, applying their best practices in building homes for its members.

DHSUD is enjoining more sectoral groups to join the call to address the country's housing backlog pegged at more than 6.5 million units in accordance with President Marcos' Pambansang Pabahay para sa Pilipino: Zero ISF 2028 Program which aims to build 1 million units every year in the next six years.

To date, the DHSUD has conducted groundbreaking ceremonies in several areas in Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao and engaged LGUs to support the program. (PNA)
