

DTI CALABARZON distributes P440K worth of starter kits to Cavite MSMEs

TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite (PIA) -- The Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) CALABARZON recently distributed P440,000 worth of starter kits to 55 Medium, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in the province thru its Livelihood Seedling Program-Negosyo Serbisyo sa Barangay (LSP-NSB).

DTI-Regional Operations Group Assistant Secretary Dominic Tolentino, Jr. and DTI IV-A Director Marilou Q. Toledo led the distribution of the starter kits to the MSMEs beneficiaries in two separate occasions in the municipalities of Amadeo, July 29 with 20 beneficiaries, and Magallanes, Aug 3 with 35 beneficiaries. Starter kits for sari-sari store, carinderia, food manufacturing, salon and barbershop, laundry, baking, tailoring and printing supplies were handed over to the MSMEs beneficiaries.

In her message, Director Toledo emphasized her hopes for the success success of the LSP-NSB program, underscoring its positive effect in the barangay-level economy.

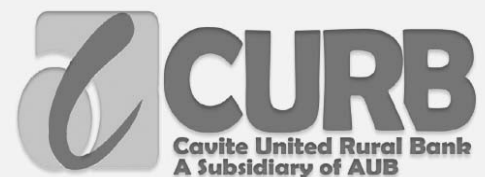

DTI developed the LSP-NSB in accordance with the directive of President Rodrigo R. Duterte to help the country's base of the pyramid and to support a grassroots approach for enterprise development, in-

crease the awareness of barangay officials on the different services offered by the Department through the Negosyo Centers, and conduct business development assistance and services in barangays.

MSME beneficiaries of the program may include sole proprietors, cooperatives, or sectoral associations that are located in identified barangays, including those in Local Communist Armed Conflict (LCAC) affected

areas, vulnerable communities like the indigenous people, refugees, and stateless persons with priority assistance given to small businesses affected by natural and human-induced calamities including health crisis arising from epidemics and pandemics.

Amid the COVID-19 pandemic, the LSP-NSB program targets to benefit 27 barangays in the 4th and 5th class municipalities in Cavite this year.

More than 50 barangay officials face suspension over SAP mess

Around 50 barangay (village) chairpersons may face suspension over alleged anomalies in the distribution of the social amelioration program (SAP).

In a televised meeting with President Rodrigo Duterte late Monday, Interior Secretary Eduardo Año said the Office of the Ombudsman will issue preventive suspension orders against barangay chairmen for alleged malversation, corruption, estafa, and graft.

He said the Criminal Investigation and Detection Group (CIDG) has filed 155 criminal complaints about SAP anomalies.

"I am now coordinating with Ombudsman Martires to submit the cases and within the week we expect a preventive suspension order to be released against 50 barangay captain while the Ombudsman will conduct a probe on the administrative aspect of their cases," Año told President Duterte.

Based on their initial investigation, Año said those who may be suspended include 26 barangay chairpersons in NCR and Region 1 (Ilocos Region); 11 in Region 4-A (Calabarzon); 10 in Region 2 (Cagayan Valley); and three in Region 3 (Central Luzon).

"This is just an initial list and there are others to follow in the course of the investigation of the Ombudsman," he stressed.

The cases filed are in violation of the Republic Act 3019 of the Anti-Graft and Corrupt Practices Act, RA 6713 Code of Conduct and Ethical Standards, and the Bayanihan to Heal as One Act, among others while cases of robbery extortions and grave threats have been filed against some of the officials.

Duterte, meanwhile, thanked Año for filing criminal complaints against local government officials accused of misusing cash aid from the government's social amelioration program.

"I'd like to thank Secretary Año, for his work in going after corrupt officials," he said. I am happy with Secretary Año's work." (PNA)

DOJ chief urges other senior PhilHealth execs to go on leave

MANILA – Department of Justice Secretary Menardo Guevarra urged other officials of Philippine Health Insurance Corp. (PhilHealth) implicated in the state insurer's alleged anomalies to go on leave to give investigators a free-hand in the ongoing probe.

In a message to reporters, Guevarra, who sits as convenor in the task force investigating PhilHealth, said six PhilHealth regional officials have already filed their leaves of absence.

"I am glad that the regional vice presidents of PhilHealth have voluntarily heeded my call for them to take a leave of absence while the investigations are going on, in order to preclude any suspicion that their presence may lead to a suppression of evidence and thus hamper the conduct of these investigations," Guevarra said.

Two former officials of PhilHealth have agreed to disclose details of the anomalies hounding the state insurer, the DOJ earlier said.

"I hope that the officials at the PhilHealth main office who have already been tagged in the ongoing congressional inquiries in aid of legislation, as well as those identified by the PACC (Presidential Anti-Corruption Commission), would likewise take a temporary leave so that Task Force PhilHealth may freely perform its mandate," he added.

PhilHealth is currently being investigated by the Senate and the task force led by the DOJ.

DOJ spokesperson Undersecretary Markk Perete said these officials who requested anonymity have informed the task force during its meeting on Friday of the different fraudulent schemes allegedly employed through the years by PhilHealth officers and employees, both in its main and regional offices, in collusion with some doctors and hospitals,

and even banks, which act as remittance centers.

"These schemes include the payment of false or fraudulent claims against the corporation, malversation of premiums, and the exploitation by some unscrupulous personalities of the case rate system and the interim reimbursement mechanism, among others," Perete said.

Guevarra said the scope of the task force's work would include "the completion of any ongoing investigations or special audits, and resolution of any pending cases, regarding PhilHealth irregularities (which) will be expedited."

The task force is composed of representatives of the Office of the Ombudsman, Commission on Audit, Civil Service Commission, PACC, Office of the Special Assistant to the President, Anti-Money Laundering Council, National Bureau of

Palace saddened by record-high adult joblessness

MANILA – Malacañang on Monday was “saddened” by a Social Weather Stations (SWS) survey result which showed that nearly half of the country’s adult labor force was jobless in July 2020.

Presidential Spokesperson Harry Roque said the SWS’s July 3-6 National Mobile Phone Survey which found adult joblessness hitting a record high 45.5 percent was expected due to restrictions imposed to contain the coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19) pandemic.

“We are of course saddened but that’s to be expected with the lockdowns that we’ve had because of Covid-19,” Roque said in a virtual Palace briefing.

Despite the figure that eclipsed the previous record high of 34.4 percent logged in March 2012, Roque said

he was still pleased that the joblessness rate turned out better than expected considering the country has been on a lockdown since March 2020, the longest lockdown in the world.

“Ako po’y nagagalak na hindi tayo 100 percent nawalan ng trabaho kasi sa tagal po na naka-lockdown tayo. Talagang I’m still surprised at our resilience at 45 percent pa lang po nawawalan ng trabaho (I’m still happy that we didn’t reach 100 percent joblessness because we’ve had long lockdowns. I’m still surprised at our resilience that our joblessness is only at 45 percent). It could have been worse,” Roque said.

According to Roque, the national government is finding ways to address the needs of Filipinos severely affected by the impact of Covid-related lockdowns by slowly reopening the economy.

He said that with government funds quickly depleting, the only solution is to allow citizens to resume their livelihood with minimum health and safety standards in place.

“I personally belong to the school of thought that we can live with Covid, we need to learn how to live our lives with Covid,” he said.

He also noted that financial assistance is available for micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs).

“I think government is looking at opening the economy and providing financial assistance to small and medium scale enterprises and also assistance to strategic businesses even if it is not small and medium scale,” he said.

Metro Manila, Cavite, Laguna, Rizal and Bulacan will be under modified enhanced community quarantine (MECQ) status until Tuesday (August 18) to allow a recalibration of the country’s healthcare capacity.



President Rodrigo Duterte is expected to announce new quarantine classifications for Metro Manila and nearby provinces after meeting with members of his Cabinet on Monday night.

Last week, Duterte admitted that he is having difficulty balancing health and economy after reverting Metro Manila and nearby provinces to MECQ status.

He wanted to heed the request of medical front-liners to extend the MECQ until the end of the month to slowdown the spread of the coronavirus disease, but was unsure of where the government would get funds for its social amelioration program.

The July 2020 SWS Survey showed that the estimated number of jobless adults was at 27.3 million in July 2020 and 7.9 million in December 2019.

Adults who are jobless consists of those who voluntarily left their old jobs, are seeking jobs for the first time, or lost their jobs due to economic circumstances beyond their control. (PNA)
