WOMEN LP SOLONS SEEK TO EXEMPT OFWS FROM PHILHEALTH CONTRIBUTIONS

Women Liberal Party (LP) lawmakers Reps. Leila de Lima (Mamayang Liberal [ML] Party-list), Arlene "Kaka" Bag-ao (Lone District, Dinagat Islands), and Cielo Krisel Lagman (1st District, Albay) have filed an amendatory bill to Republic Act (RA) No. 11223 or the "Universal Healthcare (UHC) Act" seeking to exempt Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs) from mandatory Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) contributions.

In filing House Bill No. 6355, the Women LP solons—collectively known as the "LP Tres Marias"—aim to amend Section 4(f) of the UHC law, removing "migrant workers" from the list of "direct contributors", and making their PhilHealth contributions voluntary.

"Given their indispensable role in national development, OFWs deserve relief from redundant and excessive statutory burdens. Making PhilHealth contributions voluntary is therefore not only a matter of fairness but also of sound public policy and social justice," the lady solons said.

Ang NINGNING PHPC initiative ay isang malakihan at makabagong renewable energy project na binuo sa pamamagitan ng pakikipagtulungan ng Solaris at ng kilalang property developer na Raemulan Lands Inc.

Sa ilalim ng proyektong ito, itinayo ang isang 6.55-megawatt peak (MWp) solar rooftop system na naka-install sa bubong ng 1,986 na kabahayan. Isa itong patunay na posibleng pagsamahin ang pag-unlad ng pabahay at ang paglipat tungo sa malinis na enerhiya.

Na-energize ang proyektong noong Oktubre 2024, at nakatakdang maghatid ng malinis, renewable, at panlipunang nakapagpapabuti na enerhiya para sa mga komunidad at industriya ng Pilipinas. Inaasahan itong magbibigay ng mas mababang gastos sa kuryente, habang tumutulong sa pambansang layunin ng pagharap sa hamon ng climate change.

Ayon kay Jose Alfonso Miras, VP for Business Development at Deputy CEO ng Solaris, ang brand na NINGNING ay nakatuon sa paglikha ng mga solusyong pang-enerhiya na may "redemptive" o nakapagpapabago sa buhay—mga proyektong nagbibigay ng pangmatagalang suportang sa adhikain ng "homing

Health coverage extends to their dependents, the same protection can be achieved through voluntary and flexible contribution schemes without imposing undue financial strain on our overseas worker," they added.

Since the enactment of RA 11223 in 2019, which aims to ensure that every Filipino has equitable access to quality and affordable health care services, several gaps and areas for improvement have surfaced, necessitating appropriate legislative action.

One of these areas concerns the inclusion of migrant workers or OFWs in the definition of direct contributors mandated to make premium payments to PhilHealth.

Under Section 4(f) of the UHC Act, direct contributors are defined as "those who have the capacity to pay premiums, are gainfully employed and are bound by an employer-employee relationship, or are self-earning, professional practitioners, migrant workers, including their qualified dependents, and lifetime members."

Furthermore, as mandated under Section 10 of the UHC Act, PhilHealth premium contributions have steadily increased from 2.75% of the member's monthly basic salary in 2019 to 5% in 2025.

While this provision sought to promote universal and inclusive health coverage, its implementation has imposed unintended financial and administrative burdens on OFWs who already maintain health insurance

DOST, LGU-Rosario promote biogas technology and wastewater solutions for Sustainable Agriculture

In a continued effort to promote sustainable waste management practices and green

energy solutions, the Department of Science and Technology (DOST)-Batangas and the

Local Government Unit (LGU) of Rosario, conducted a seminar titled "Biogas Technology

and Wastewater Solutions: From Site Assessment to Knowledge Sharing" at the Function

Room of Rosario Resort and Hotel, Barangay Quilib, Rosario, Batangas, October 21.

To provide expert insights on biogas and wastewater technologies, DOST-Batangas

engaged specialists from DOST-Rizal and the Industrial Technology Development

Institute (DOST-ITDI). The seminar brought together local government officials,

agricultural stakeholders, and industry experts to discuss biogas integration and wastewater treatment applications for sustainable farm operations. It also featured the

presentation of findings from the Technology Needs Assessment (TNA) and

Gas Quality Assessment earlier conducted in livestock farms located in Barangays Itugan and

Mayuro, Rosario, Batangas. Ms. Una Grace M. Dollete, Senior Science Research Specialist of DOST

Rizal, opened the technical sessions with a lecture on the Overview of Biogas and DOST-CALABARZON's

Biogas Technology, underscoring the environmental and economic benefits of biogas

systems for farm-based communities. Engr. Johnemma Mae Chuayana, Science Research Analyst from DOST-ITDI, followed

with a presentation on DOST-ITDI Biogas Technology, discussing recent innovations and

successful applications of biogas systems developed by ITDI. Engr. Rochelle Retamar,

Supervising Science Research Specialist from the same institute, also introduced the

DOST-ITDI Wastewater Technology, highlighting its importance in minimizing

pollution and sup-

Adding practical insights, biogas expert Mr. Fernando Ablaza, former Provincial Director of

DOST-Rizal, shared the results of the TNA and Gas Quality Assessment conducted in

due to its agricultural base and readiness for green energy initiatives. Engr. Rodelma

Perez and Mr. Adonis Eclipse, both from DOST-ITDI, also addressed technical questions

during the open forum. The seminar served

environmentally responsible practices at the community level. Participants from the LGU,

farmer groups, and private sector expressed optimism toward adopting biogas and

wastewater technologies in future local projects

Three-Day Bamboo Processing and Handicraft-Making Training Strengthens Livelihood Opportunities in Brgy. Galalan, Pangil, Laguna

The Department of Science and Technology DOST - Laguna, in collaboration with the

Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR) and the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI),

conducted a three-day training on Bamboo Processing for Handicraft Making for the

Galalan Agrarian Reform Beneficiaries Multipurpose Cooperative (Galalan ARB MPC) on

September 23-25, 2025, in Brgy. Galalan, Pangil, Laguna. Facilitated by the

DOST-Forest Products Research and Development Institute (DOST-FPRDI), the training aimed to equip cooperative members with technical knowledge and

practical skills in bamboo harvesting, processing, and handicraft production. This initiative

forms part of the ongoing effort to enhance local livelihood opportunities and promote

sustainable eco-tourism within the community. The activity commenced with an opening program through a welcome

remarks from Barangay Chairwoman Hon. Josephine Taniegra, who expressed her deep appreciation

to the partner agencies for bringing the training to Galalan. She emphasized that the skills

imparted through the program would create new avenues for livelihood and community

development. This was followed by a message from DOST-Laguna Provincial Director Ms. Agnes G. Morales, who highlighted the critical role of science, technology, and innovation

in increasing productivity and competitiveness among grassroots cooperatives. DAR

Laguna representative Mr. Juan Miguel Amara also addressed the participants, sharing

his vision for Galalan ARB MPC to become a bamboo benchmarking site and a model eco-tourism destination in the province. The technical training began with Mr. Joseph R. Lapis of DOST-FPRDI, who introduced

the goals of the bamboo training and briefly presented the programs and services offered by the Institute. He then introduced the resource speaker, Engr. James Anthony



Chan, a bamboo expert from DOST-FPRDI. Engr. Chan opened the session with a discussion on

proper techniques in harvesting and preparing bamboo, emphasizing the importance of

using the right materials to ensure product quality. He then demonstrated the basic tools

used in bamboo processing before proceeding to the hands-on activities of the training. Participants

were guided through the step-by-step production process for making bamboo

handicrafts such as trays, portable speakers, and lamp shades. A strong focus was placed

on following the Bill of Materials (BOM) to ensure efficiency, consistency, and resource

allocation. Assisting Engr. Chan were Mr. Reyes and Mr. Lastimoso, who helped

supervise the hands-on activities, allowing cooperative members to gain practical

experience in cutting, shaping, and assembling bamboo components into finished

products. On the last day, the training continued with a specialized session on Finishing Techniques

for Bamboo Handicraft Making, led again by Engr. Chan. This session highlighted the

importance of proper finishing in enhancing both the durability and aesthetic appeal of

bamboo products. Topics covered included sanding, smoothing, polishing, and the application of protective coatings. Engr. Chan stressed that high-quality finishing is

essential in producing market-ready products that meet customer expectations and quality

standards. Following the lecture, participants were once again engaged in hands-on

activities, applying finishing techniques to the items they had crafted the previous day. Under close supervision, cooperative members practiced the techniques and received

individualized guidance and feedback from the trainers. The three-day training concluded with a brief closing program. Messages of support were

delivered by a DAR representative and by Engr. Wilma G. Del Rosario, who both praised

the active participation of the Galalan ARB MPC members. The DAR representative

assured the cooperative of continued support not only through trainings but also by

providing future access to bamboo facilities and necessary equipment to sustain their

livelihood efforts. Engr. Del Rosario encouraged the participants to apply their

newfound skills and emphasized the importance of continuous practice to improve

craftsmanship. Engr. Chan also offered final words of encouragement, reminding the cooperative that

mastering bamboo handicraft production takes time, patience, and consistency. Overall, the training

effectively introduced bamboo processing and handicraft-making techniques to the

Galalan ARB MPC, while strengthening the collaboration among DOST, DAR, and DTI. The initiative is a significant step toward empowering the community of

Brgy. Galalan, equipping its members with the tools and knowledge needed to develop

bamboo-based enterprises and transform the barangay into a thriving bamboo livelihood

and eco-tourism site in Laguna
