EDITORIAL

DENR, kailan kikilos sa problemang air pollution

Nagluwag na ng restrictions sa Metro Manila. Marami nang bukas na establimento. Balik na rin ang maraming sasakyan sa Metro Manila, mapri-bado at publiko. Kaya balik sa buhol-buhol na trapik. Marami nang yumayaot at tiyak na lalo pang sisikip dahil sa Christmas season.

Pero hindi ang trapik ang labis na nakakatakot kundi ang usok ng mga sasakyan na nakakasulasok-. Sa dami ng mga sasakyang hindi na namimintina, ang problema sa air pollution ay nakaamba at unti-unting pumapatay sa mamamayan. Wala ring ipinag-kaiba sa COVID-19 ang air pollution. At wala namang hakbang ang Department of Environment and Na-tural Resources (DENR) ukol sa problemang ito. Dedma.

Ayon sa pag-aaral, 80 percent na pinagmumulan ng air pollution sa Metro Manila ay mga hindi namimintinang sasakyan gaya ng mga karag-karag na dyipni, taxi, trak at traysikel. Pinagmumulan din ng pollution ang mga usok mula sa pabrika at sinusunog na basura.

Sa ilalim ng Clean Air Act of 1999, mahigpit na ipinagbabawal ang pagsusunog ng mga basura at paggamit ng incinerators. Nawalan ng silbi ang batas- kaya ngayon, balik na naman sa may lasong hangin na nabawasan na noong nakaraang taon nang magsimula ang pandemya.

Kapansin-pansin na wala na ang mga operatiba ng DENR na nanghuhuli sa smoke belchers. Mabuti pa ang Manila Bay at pinagaganda ng DENR sa pamamagitan ng pagtatambak ng dolomite. Pinondohan ng P389 milyon para maging kaakit-akit. Pero ang paglilinis sa hangin, wala silang hakbang.

Ayon sa Department of Health (DOH), ang maru-ming hangin ay nagdulot ng noncommunicable diseases (NCDs) gaya ng allergies, acute respiratory infections, chronic obstructive pulmonary diseases, cancer at cardiovascular diseases.

Bumababa na ang kaso ng COVID-19 kaya pa-tuloy ang pagluwag sa restrictions. Lahat nang sasak--yan ay maaari nang pumasok sa Metro na lubhang delikado. Bumababa ang kaso ng COVID pero mala-mang na sa air pollution naman mamatay ang mamamayan. Makagawa sana ng paraan ang DENR sa problemang ito bago maging huli ang lahat. Hindi dapat haya-ang lumala ang problema sa air pollution.

“Huwag kang mapapagod BBM, nasa likod mo lang kami, nasa likod mo ang taumbayan (Don’t get tired BBM, we are behind you, the people are behind you)!”

This was the cry of the Caviteños as the BBM-Sara UniTeam’s Unity Caravan rocked and rolled in the province on Thursday.

BBM-Sara Uniteam said some women were in tears when they greeted the pick-up truck carrying Partido Federal ng Pilipinas (PFP) standard bearer Ferdinand ‘Bongbong’ Marcos Jr.(BBM), and running-mate Davao Mayor Inday Sara Duterte of Partido Lakas-CMD, while traversing the stretch of Bacoor to Rosario.

“Huwag kang mapapagod BBM (Don’t get tired DDM). Nasa likod mo kami (We are behind you). Matagal ka naming inantay (We have been waiting for so long),!” cried an old woman who couldn’t help but cry as Bongbong beamed at her with the sweetest smile.

It is estimated that as many as hundreds of thou-

sands of Caviteño supporters came out of their homes to show their warm support for BBM-Sara UniTeam.

The euphoria was similar with the previous scene described as “sea of humanity” in Quezon City, the all-day sortie from Bacoor City and the towns of Noveleta, Rosario and Kawit were attended also by thousands who support the tandem.

Most of the supporters sporting red and green clothes patiently waited for the arrival of the BBM-Sara UniTeam caravan.

Some of them are waving the Philippine flag. A man showed a ‘sculpture’ of the face of former President Ferdinand Marcos Sr. while a Caviteño also wore a barong tagalog combined with a traditional Filipino hat and red neckerchief depict-



ing a brave Filipino.

Cavite, with an estimated 2.1 million registered voters since 2019 and considered one of the vote-rich provinces in the country, is also widely known as “Lalawigan ng Magiting (The Province of the Brace).”

The people chanted at the top of their lungs “Bongbong-Sara” with their hands in victory sign signifying BBM and their other hand in clenched fist signifying Inday Sara.

The motorcade could not barely move because most of the supporters were blocking the official vehicle of the “power duo” just to be able to shake their hands.
