

# Bacoor City farmers and hog raisers receive P5.1M cash assistance

**BACOR CITY, Cavite, Mar. 11 (PIA)-** The city government has started distributing financial support to farmers and hog raisers in this city who were affected by the African Swine Fever (ASF).

On March 4, Bacoor City Mayor Lani Mercado-Revilla led the distribution of financial assistance amounting to P5.185 million to 113 hog raisers from Barangays

San Nicolas 3, Queens Row Central, East and West, Molino 2, Molino 3, Molino 6, and Molino 7.

Aside from the cash assistance, the beneficiaries

also received gardening tools, seeds, and fertilizers as aid to start urban farming as alternative livelihood from the losses incurred.

## Look who's behind fake news

"FB page Confeirmed's fabricated quote card already got almost 5,600 FB interactions and could have reached around 755,000 netizens. The page, plus public FB groups - SEN TRILLANES POWER and VP Leni Robredo Angel Warriors International -- are the post's top traffic generators".

This is part of the findings of fact-checker Vera Files which slammed the Facebook page "Confeirmed for fabricating a quote ascribed to Sen. Christopher Lawrence "Bong" Go as saying he will suggest to Pres. Rodrigo Duterte to replace "whining government employees" with Chinese workers by granting them civil service eligibility.

Ellen Tordesillas, president of Vera Files bluntly said that the statement which had been making the rounds in social media was fabricated by Confeirmed and dubbed it Fake. The other damning revelation which the fact-checker bared was that two other Facebook groups, namely "Senator Trillanes Power and "VP Leni Robredo Angel Warriors International" are Confeirmed's posts top traffic generators.

Vera Files noted that the fake quote was published on March 1 on Facebook (FB) by Confeirmed, which also regularly publishes content critical of the Duterte administration.

Knowing that Vera Files is also critical of Duterte's administration, I inquired from Ellen to ascertain whether their report I read on FB is true. Her response was straight forward: "Jun, we do not want lies, regardless of political color". Well, that's the fact-checker speaking and she even enunciated that "the neophyte senator did not make such a statement"

Says Vera Files: "A cursory search of the whole quote and a keyword search using only parts of the quote have yielded no official record or document proving that Go really made the statement. No media organization reported on it either."

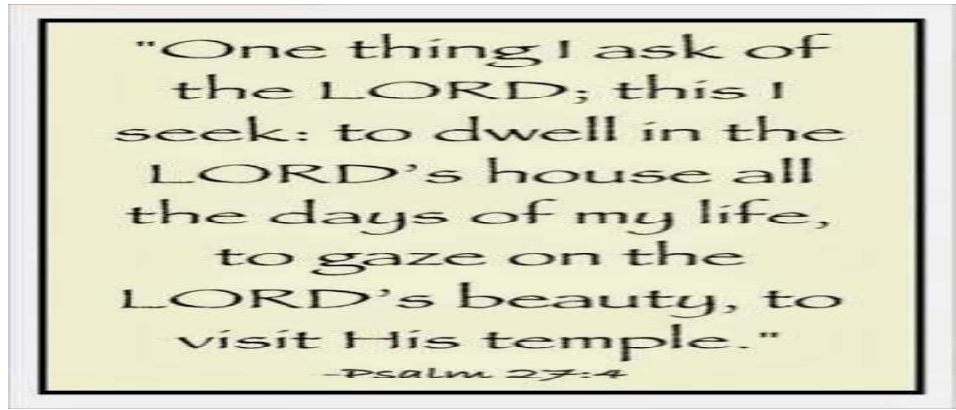
This is the third attempt to discredit Pres. Rodrigo Duterte by opposition quarters by implicating Bong Go in some shenanigans knowing how intimate and trusted he is to the Chief Executive. The first try was when they made a fuss over a scribbled note on the documents that pertain to the purchase of naval frigates which Bong, who was then head of the Presidential Staff, referred to the Department of National Defense for appropriate action. He was summoned by the Senate even as the head of the Navy, Vice Admiral Ronald Mercado, declared that Bong has nothing to do with the frigate deal which was approved by the Aquino administration.

The second try was when the so-called whistle-blower alias "Bikoy" linked him to a fairy tale titled "Ang Totoong Narco List" which was later debunked by Jumel Advincula who admitted to being the hooded man Bikoy.

And then the preposterous story of Confeirmed which quoted the Senator as saying he will propose to Duterte to issue civil service eligibility to Chinese nationals so that they can replace Filipinos who complain of meager salary. The idiots behind Confeirmed did not even check whether this is possible under the Philippine laws.

Well, Bong Go had become enured to the desperate moves of the dying opposition he simply issued a brief denial and went on with his work in the senate and untiringly extends assistance to victims of calamities and establishing Malasakit Centers in nearly every nook and corner of the country.

A veggie fried lumpia, filled with chopped, cooked camote crop, potato, carrots, just a taste either of 1/16 of a kgm of pork, or chopped 6 pcs shrimp, shredded cabbage, and apa that will only cost us a peso per pc, will suffice for a meal! 3 pcs of it, standard size, make me full, add at least 250 ml mineral water and bingo, i have my lunch.. The 3-pc fried veggie lumpia costs me Php 14.00 in all and kunyari i am an ofc worker, mineral water na pantulak ko is only Php 8.00 = Php 22 per meal.

A diabetic, i need to shy away from consuming rice. One or two meals that I skip having rice is better. The veggies inside the fried lumpia ay nakakabusog na.

Also, we prepare isang klase na lang na ulam or viand per meal. We just need to do it now as we are in a critical situation.

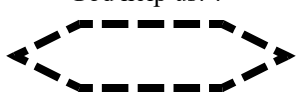
For our household of 4 adults, ang katipiran na sistema sa pagkain ay hindi po sakripisyo. Rather, it is the right way of consumption!

## DOH REPORTS 4+9 NEW COVID-19 CASES; TOTAL NOW 33

The Department of Health (DOH) reported nine (9) new confirmed cases (PH25-33) of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), on top of the four (4) new cases (PH21-24) announced yesterday evening, March 9, 2020. This brings the total number of confirmed cases in the country to 33.

DOH also clarified that the 11 new cases announced earlier today are in fact new positive samples and not cases. Upon verification, DOH reported that two (2) of the new positive samples received by the Epidemiology Bureau (EB) of DOH are repeat tests on samples taken from cases PH7 and PH8.

The 13 new cases are admitted at various hospitals: the Dr. Jose N. Rodriguez Memorial Hospital and Sanitarium (PH21), Cardinal Santos Medical Center (PH22), San Lazaro Hospital (PH23), St. Luke's Medical Center Quezon City (PH24), New Clark City (NCC) quarantine facility (PH25-26, MVDP repatriates), and the Medical City (PH27-33), respectively.

Of the 13 new cases, PH21-24 are currently in stable condition, PH25-26 are asymptomatic, and statuses of PH27-33 are for verification.

The EB of DOH is conducting comprehensive con-

tact tracing activities for all cases. DOH is also in close coordination with concerned Local Government Units and Centers for Health Development for the implementation of infection prevention and control measures at the local level, and the Philippine National Police and other government agencies and concerned stakeholders for identification and management of close contacts.

"With the increasing number of cases, I implore everyone to fully cooperate with us in investigation and contact tracing activities. Individuals with a known history of exposure and travel presenting with mild symptoms are advised to self-isolate and undergo home quarantine for 14 days. Those presenting severe and critical symptoms need to be immediately admitted to health facilities. Please contact DOH and call the designated hotline at (02) 8-651-7800 loc 1149-1150 for appropriate management and referral," Health Secretary Francisco T. Duque said.

"I would like to again remind everyone to please help us help you. Practice personal preventive measures such as proper hand hygiene, cough etiquette, and social distancing. We also advise everyone to avoid visiting public places and/or attending mass gatherings at this critical time. Only with your cooperation and support can we win our fight against COVID-19," the Health Chief concluded.

1 box (1 ounce) unflavored gelatin (I used Knox)

4 cups water

2 tablespoons instant coffee

1/2 cup sugar

1 can (14 ounces) condensed milk

1 can (12.8 ounces) table cream

Get Ingredients Powered by Chicory

Instructions

In a sauce pot, bring 3 cups of the water to a boil. Add instant coffee and sugar. Stir until dissolved.

In a large bowl, sprinkle the gelatin on the remaining 1 cup of cold water. Let stand for about 1 minute or until gelatin powder begins to bloom.

Gradually add the 3 cups of boiling coffee and stir con-



stantly for about 2 to 3 minutes or until gelatin is completely dissolved and no granules are visible.

Transfer mixture into a baking dish and allow to completely cool. Refrigerate for about 2 to 3 hours or until completely set.

In a bowl, combine condensed milk and table cream. Stir until blended.

Cut set gelatin into 1-inch cubes and divide into serving cups. Top with sweetened cream. Garnish with whipped cream, if desired. Serve cold.

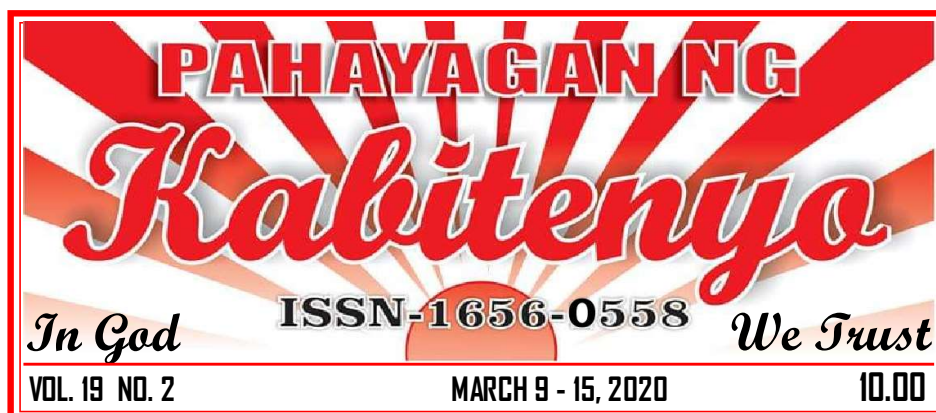


Municipal Hall. These are only some of the preventive measures the Municipal Government is implementing against the spread of coronavirus disease (COVID-19).
