

# With the approval of Bayanihan 2, DILG begins hiring 50,000 contact tracers

The Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) will start tomorrow the recruitment, hiring, and training of at least 50,000 contact tracers nationwide to significantly ramp-up the country's contact tracing program following the signing by the President of the "Bayanihan to Recover as One Act" or Bayanihan 2 Law.

DILG Secretary Eduardo M. Año said that the additional 50,000 contact tracers are "the game-changer in the country's COVID-response since this will allow us to cut the transmission of the disease and ultimately defeat COVID-19."

"We welcome the signing of Bayanihan 2 Law for it means that we can now go ahead and start the hiring process for additional contact tracers urgently needed by the various Local Government Units nationwide. Again, we thank the President and Congress for allocating much-needed funds for our COVID response," he said.

"The DILG is looking for dedicated and patriotic individuals who want to join the fight against COVID-19. If you want to take an active part in defeating the pandemic, join the DILG Contact Tracing Teams!," he said.

He said that the 50,000 contact tracers to be hired will be assigned to the various Contact Tracing Teams (CTTs) of the Local Government Units. At present, the Contact Tracing Teams are composite units led by the Municipal/City Health Officers with members from the Philippine National Police, Bureau of Fire Protection, Barangay Health Emergency Response Teams (BHERTS), and volunteers from Civil Society Organizations (CSOs).

There are currently 97,400 contact tracers nationwide and the additional contact tracers will allow the country to reach the target of 150,000 contact tracers. "With the additional 50,000 contact tracers, we will now be able to meet the Magalong formula of tracing 37 close contacts of 1 COVID patient up to the 3rd degree," he said.

Under the guidelines drafted by the DILG, the con-

tact tracers will earn a minimum of P18,784 per month in a contract of service status. Among their responsibilities are to conduct interviews, profiling, and perform an initial public health risk assessment of COVID-19 cases and their identified close contacts; refer the close contacts to isolation facilities; conduct enhanced contact tracing in collaboration with other agencies and private sectors; conduct daily monitoring of close and general contacts for at least 14 days, and perform such other tasks in relation to the COVID response.

## WHO solidarity trials might start end Oct, says DOH exec

MANILA – The World Health Organization (WHO) solidarity trials on the coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19) vaccines might start by the last week of October, a health official said Friday.

"(In) the fourth week of October, the implementation might start already. And I say the implementation might start because there could be a lot of factors, in-

tervening factors, that the dates might be moved. But based on the discussions September 9, this is what we have agreed upon," Department of Health Undersecretary Maria Rosario Vergeire said in a mix of Filipino and English during a virtual media forum.

Citing the timeline from the WHO, Vergeire said the vaccines to be included in the solidarity trial would be identified in the third or fourth week of September while the sites for the conduct of the trials would

be identified by the end of September.

"We will be monitoring this and we hope we can pursue this based on the specific timeline that was given to us," she said.

The solidarity trial is an international clinical trial to test the effectiveness of a possible vaccine for Covid-19.

The Philippines' participation in the WHO solidarity trial was approved by the Single Joint Research Ethics Board on April 17 in support of the Covid-19 global response. (PNA)

**DA 4A turns over P2.6M worth of agricultural interventions to Magallanes farmers**

CALAMBACITY, Laguna, (PIA) --The Department of Agriculture (DA) Region IV-CALABARZON, through its High Value Crops Development Program (HVCDP) and Taal Recovery and Rehabilitation Program, turned over P2,687,250 worth of agricultural interventions, including a newly built 72-square meter packing house, to the Magallanes-Samahang Magsasaka ng Kay-Apas at Medina Association (MAG-SAMAKAME) and other farmers' groups in Magallanes, Cavite on September 17, 2020.

Regional Director Arnel V. de Mesa graced the activity and expressed his appreciation for the resilience of the farmers of Magallanes. He said that agriculture is thriving during this pandemic and was the only sector to register a 1.6 percent positive growth, according to the Philippine Statistics Authority.

"For the remaining months of 2020, the national government allocated an additional P24 billion for the agriculture sector to aid people's food requirement during this pandemic. We, at the regional office, will make sure that from this additional financial injection, there will be an allocation for Magallanes," Director de Mesa said.

Director de Mesa added that the regional office will support Magallanes to become the vegetable bowl of Cavite. "DA's support won't stop in here. I have instructed our Regional Livestock Program Coordinator to distribute cattle, goats, and poultry to farmers in Magallanes affected by Taal eruption," he said.

Magallanes Mayor, Hon. Jasmin Angelli Maligaya-Bautista shared her utmost gratitude for the continued support of DA for the Magallanes farmers.

"The agriculture department is very close to my heart and today we are very lucky to have them here and giving us this new packing house and other agricultural interventions. During this pandemic, the people of Magallanes were never hungry, thanks to the hard work and commitment of our farmers and full support from DA. With our collaborative effort, farming in Magallanes will improve significantly," Mayor Bautista said.

Mr. Freddie D. Sisante, the Municipal Agriculture Officer (MAO) of Magallanes, welcomed the regional office officials and expressed his thanks for giving MAG-SAMAKAME a newly built packing house.

"This facility from DA was built in a very strategic location for farmers to consolidate and repack-age their harvests before delivering their products to nearby areas and Metro Manila," MAO Sisante said.

MAG-SAMAKAME Chairman Mr. Jose Mariano Maligaya shared how grateful he is for the newly built packing house to be used by their association.

"This packing house from DA will save us more time and money because we no longer have to rent a place to sort our harvest. Our current packing house is also small and has only plastic as shade, which is why this packing house will ensure that our products are safe and that we will have a permanent roof above our heads," Mr. Maligaya said.

Aside from the packing house containing 38 pieces of plastic crates and one heavy-duty weighing scale, MAG-SAMAKAME and other farmers associations in Magallanes also received 15 kilograms of assorted vegetable seeds, 150 seedling trays, 15 knapsack sprayers, three power sprayers, 15 plastic mulch, and 40 bags of complete fertilizer under the regional HVCDP.

Moreover, Magallanes farmers received 475 bags of organic fertilizers, 475 bags of vermicast, 500 bags of complete fertilizers, and 500 bags of muriate of potash through DA's Taal recovery and rehabilitation program. (PIA-4A/DA CALABARZON RAFIS)

## Carmona LGU inaugurates Mega Isolation Facility for COVID patients

CARMONA, Cavite, (PIA) -- The local government of Carmona inaugurated the Mega Isolation Facility located in CarSiGMA (Carmona-Silang- Gen. Mariano Alvarez) Gymnasium in Barangay Lantic on Saturday, September 5, 2020.

Mayor Atty. Roy Loyola along with DPWH USEC Emil Sadain led the inauguration of the Mega Isolation Facility, a repurposed evacuation center, consisting of about 151 cubicles.

With the partnership between the local government unit and the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), the facility was constructed with a budget of Php6M.

DPWH Sec. Mark Villar, represented by USEC Emil Sadain said the facility will facilitate treatment and care of COVID-19 patients of Carmona and nearby industrial zones.

"This is considered a Mega Facility because the total bed capacity reached 151 compared to average or normal isolation facilities

built by the DPWH with about 45 bed capacities only," Sadain commented.

The facility also have provisions for doctors and medical healthworkers quarters, and equipped with CCTV cameras to monitor the pa
