During the Centennial year (2018-2019) Optimist International does offer us some membership incentives to assist us for the 2018-2019 Optimist year, which are as follows:

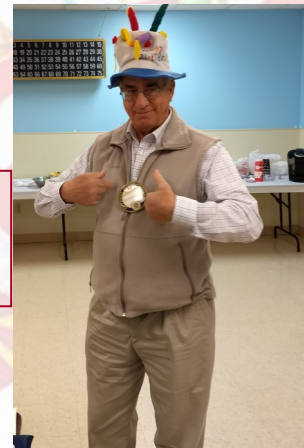
Persons under 30 years of age can join for \$50 dues for the first year, with no application fee.
