Anderson helps student graduate debt free from college by helping students identify their own core values, and to find schools that are a good fit for the student. Anderson grew up in an extremely rural town in Tennessee, and attended a prestigious high school nearby. He attended college but did not obtain his degree from that school at that time. He later moved to Bay County where he completed his degree. Having nearly two decades of higher education experience in admissions, enrollment management, financial aid, and scholarship awarding (most recently, overseeing *Undergraduate Admissions at Saginaw Valley State University*), Anderson has helped thousands of students enroll in their dream school, and has helped students secure more than \$25 million dollars in scholarships. Anderson founded his company because in his experience families need someone to listen, and advocate for them, so that their children can reach their career and education goals without a lifetime of debt.

Last year he was contracted through the Bay Area Community foundation to work with first generation high school students, to ensure that after acceptance they actually enroll and complete their year, and re-enroll to complete their degree.


