Our program today was the *Bay Area Soccer Association (BASA)*, with presenters **Rob Clark**, *President* of the Association and **Ali Smith. Rob** and **Ali** spoke about the expansion, on the east side of Bay City, to the former tennis courts at Maplewood Park. They are putting in 2 soccer fields, mini pitches, and a basketball court in partnership with *BASA, Chamber of Commerce, City of Bay City* and *US Soccer Foundation*. Estimated cost is \$550,000 and they have raised \$387,500 so far. The fence has been taken down and the courts cleared off in preparation. They will continue to fundraise throughout the winter and in the spring have their public campaign and do resurfacing work. In the late spring or early summer they will complete the 2 soccer, mini pitches, and basketball hoops & court.

Maplewood Park is Located in between 1st and 3rd streets on the North and South, and North Sheridan and North Van Buren Streets on the East and West.
