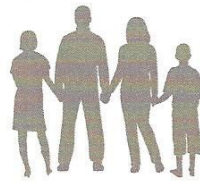

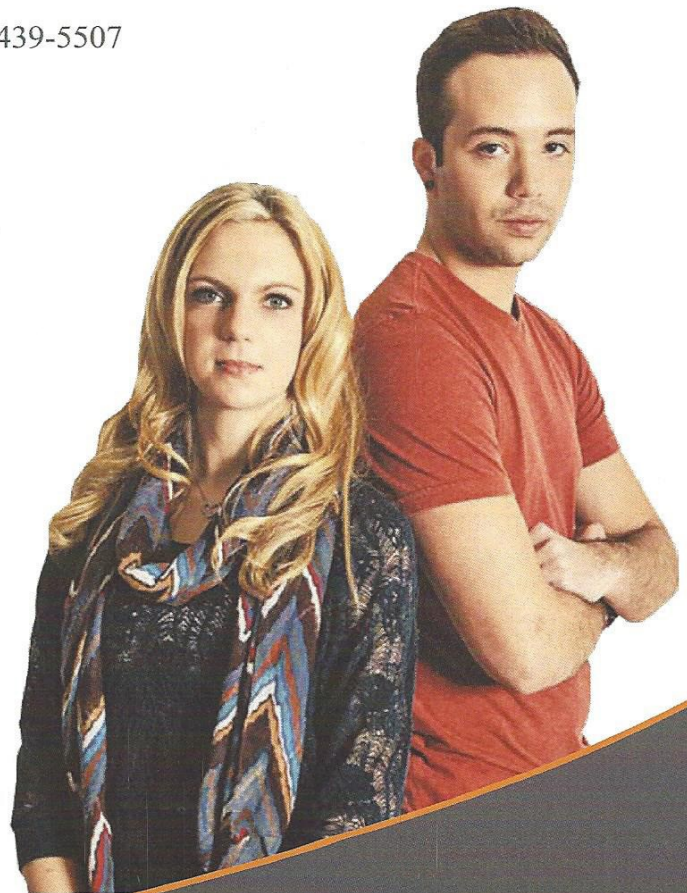

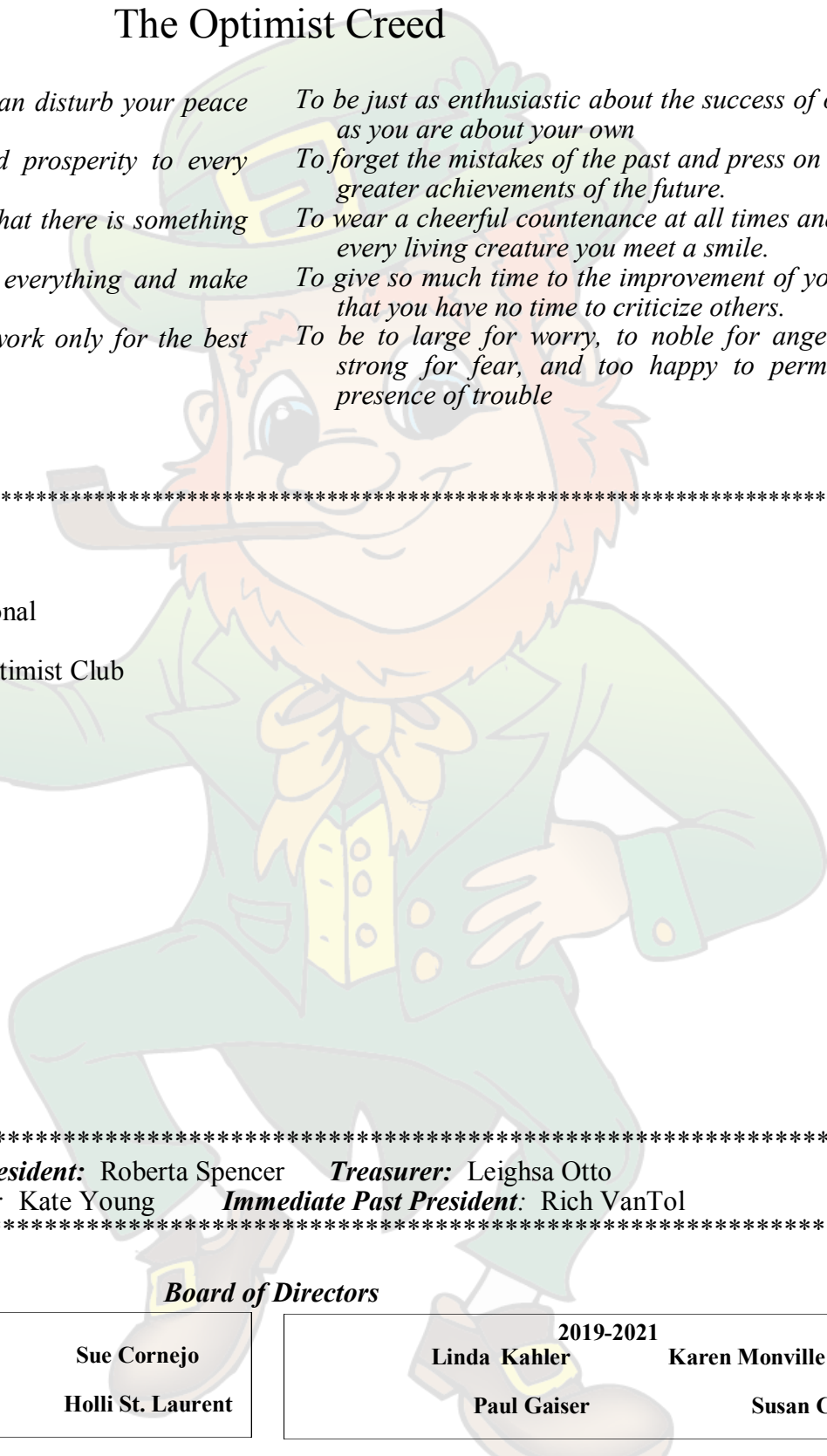
The Optimist Creed
