The above mission statement is that of the "Rock Center For Youth Development (C4YD). The C4YD has three umbrella programs, *Discover You, Grounded,* and *Unplugged*. Each of these programs serves a unique and critical need, they are highly interdependent as well as complementary of one another. Most importantly, they support the identified needs of youth in the community.

Discover You:

This program trains with impact programs, equipping middle school through early post-secondary students with youth development skills. Workshops are designed to be delivered in classrooms, sports teams, clubs, student organizations and other out of school time activities.

Grounded:

This program is a productive, after school program that instills confidence and a sense of belonging.

Unplugged:

This program is community-based teen events that encourage healthy life choices, and relationships. Unplugged creates a sense of community awareness, and allows teens to engage in safe as well as supportive social activities. Throughout the year ROCK Unplugged has multiple events for teens to go to enjoy! Some examples of different events are: Summer Camp, Pool Parties, Lock-Ins, Movie Showings, Volunteer Events
