**January 21:** 16 members and guests today. Our guest today was our speaker Katie Bell, *Community Engagement Manager*, from the *CAN Council of the Great Lakes Bay region*. The mission of the *CAN Council (Child Abuse and Neglect)* is to prevent child abuse and neglect of children in the Great Lakes Bay Region.

There are three pillars of the council:

**CAC: Child Advocacy Center.** The child is interviewed only once by all the professionals in a safe environment in an effort to streamline the process of a traumatic event so the child doesn't have to repeat the story

**CASA: Court Appointed Special Advocates.** Highly trained volunteers serving as the voice of the child. After researching the case of the child, they attend hearings, and submit a court report recommending an action to the court.

**CAPE: Child Abuse Prevention Education.** Prevention program for all ages, providing education appropriate for that age group, and also provides free parenting classes open to the public

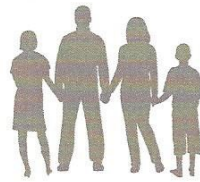

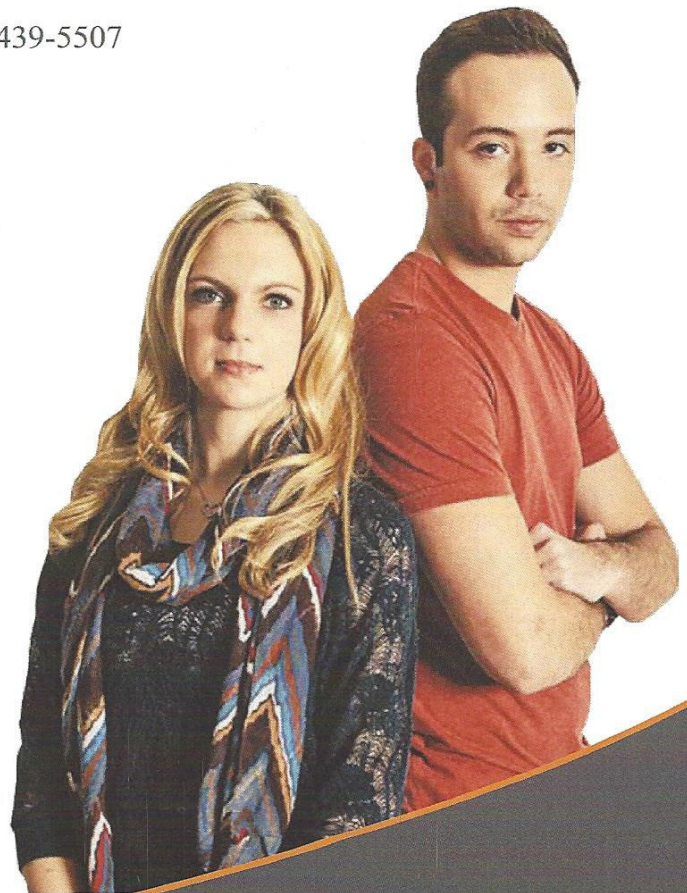
