MEETING NOTES

Our club voted on accepting the Bylaws update today, and seeing no issue those present voted to accept them. The main changes consisted of verbiage dictated by *Optimist International*

Our presenter today was **Joe Wozniak** speaking on the Bay City Cooperative Market, and their efforts to start, and open, a Brick and Mortar Store locally. You may ask "What is a food coop"?

"A cooperative or co-op is a business structure that is owned and democratically controlled by its member-owners who utilize its services."

The cooperative is formed because of the recognition by persons that as individuals they cannot achieve their economic or social goals by working separately. Only by "group-action" and through cooperation, will they be able to **achieve common objectives**.

Members who use the cooperative own the co-op. Cooperatives are **democratically controlled** in that a person owning at minimum, one share of stock is entitled to one vote during member meetings. In the case of the Bay City COOP arket, a single share of stock cost \$200, and is open to everyone.

Members **finance** the cooperative in a variety of ways. Each cooperative determines how the enterprise will be financed. Risk is limited to how much money a member has put into the business.

Members **benefit** from the cooperative based on the amount they use the co-op. All or a portion of the co-op's profits may be distributed proportionately, based on the member's use, or patronage, of the co-op.

In summary, a cooperative is an "autonomous association of persons united voluntarily to meet their common economic, social, and cultural needs and aspirations through a jointly owned and democratically-controlled enterprise." Examples: Credit Unions, Monitor Sugar(local), Condominium Associations, etc.

As with the Bay City Cooperative Market, all food coops are committed to consumer education, product quality, and member control, and usually support their local communities by selling produce grown locally by family farms.
