Our presenter today was **Kathy Rayner**, *Executive Director Literacy Council of Bay County*. **Kathy** spoke today on the state of literacy in our county, and the statistics were dismal to say the least.

Doing a little further search on my own, I found, according to the National Center for Education Statistics (nces.ed.gov/nationsreportcard), comparing statistics for student growth of Michigan, between 4th grade level and 8th grade level, one statistic that stuck out to me was between mathematics and reading was the following levels of achievement

	Less than Basic	Less than Proficient	
4th Grade Reading	42%	72%	
8th Grade Reading	32%	72%	
4th Grade Math	29%	68%	
8th Grade Math	40%	75%	

One statistic Kathy shared with us is 46% of Bay County 4th grade students are not reading at their grade level.

Kathy related a story of one of her "Students" that had a job as a dishwasher at a restaurant, and wanting to move up to a better position as a wait person, while being a very good worker, he could not move on as he could not read the menu, nor sufficiently write the order. One problem could be that besides not teaching cursive in school anymore, students are not being taught the basics of spelling, nor having spelling tests.

To me it kind of explains the dilemma of a parent wanting to Home School, Charter school, Private or Public school. While these are just a few of the different school choice programs, they are probably the most commonly thought of.

VENIMO


