More people die from the disease then lung and prostate cancers combined.

Alzheimer's falls under the umbrella of Dementia, and under the umbrella there are 4 types pf dementia, and Alzheimer's makes up anywhwere from 60-80% of the cases.

Currently there are approximately 50 million dementia cases world wide, with 5 million in the United States alone.

The greatest known risk factor for Alzheimer's is age, followed by family history and then by genetics


