Today’s guest speaker was **Abby Keeley-Scherzer** from ‘Walk To End Alzheimer’s’. Abby gave some rather stark statistics concerning Alzheimer’s, some of them are:

More people die from the disease than lung and prostate cancers combined.

Alzheimer’s falls under the umbrella of Dementia, and under the umbrella there are 4 types of dementia, and Alzheimer’s makes up anywhere from 60-80% of the cases.

Currently there are approximately 50 million dementia cases world wide, with 5 million in the United States alone.

The greatest known risk factor for Alzheimer’s is age, followed by family history and then by genetics

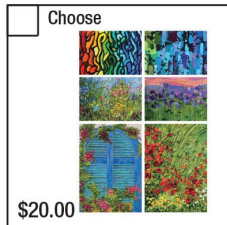

# The Optimist Creed

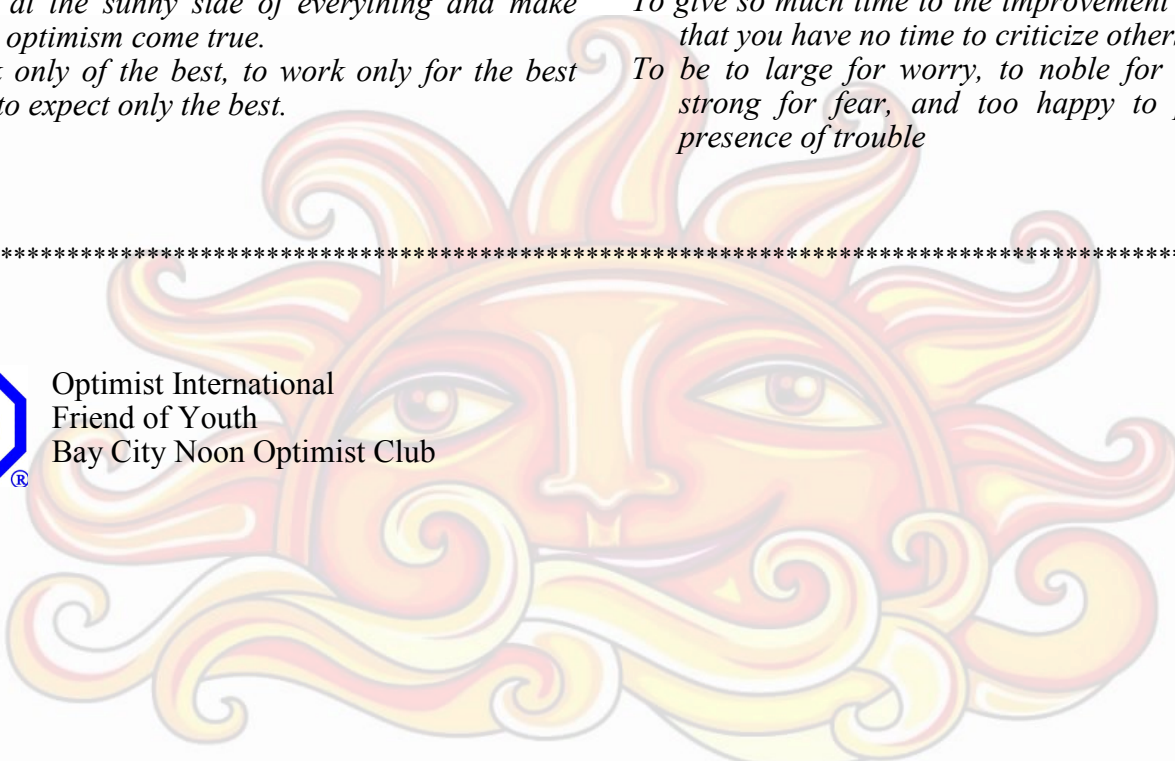
*To be so strong that nothing can disturb your peace of mind.
