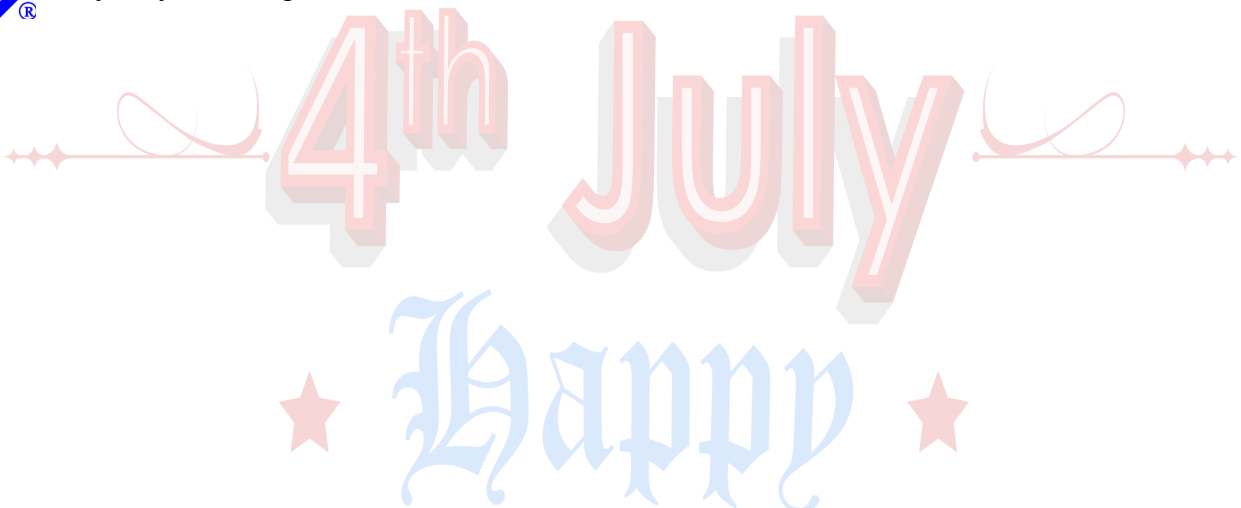
The Optimist Creed
