1: Women's Medium, Aqua Marine

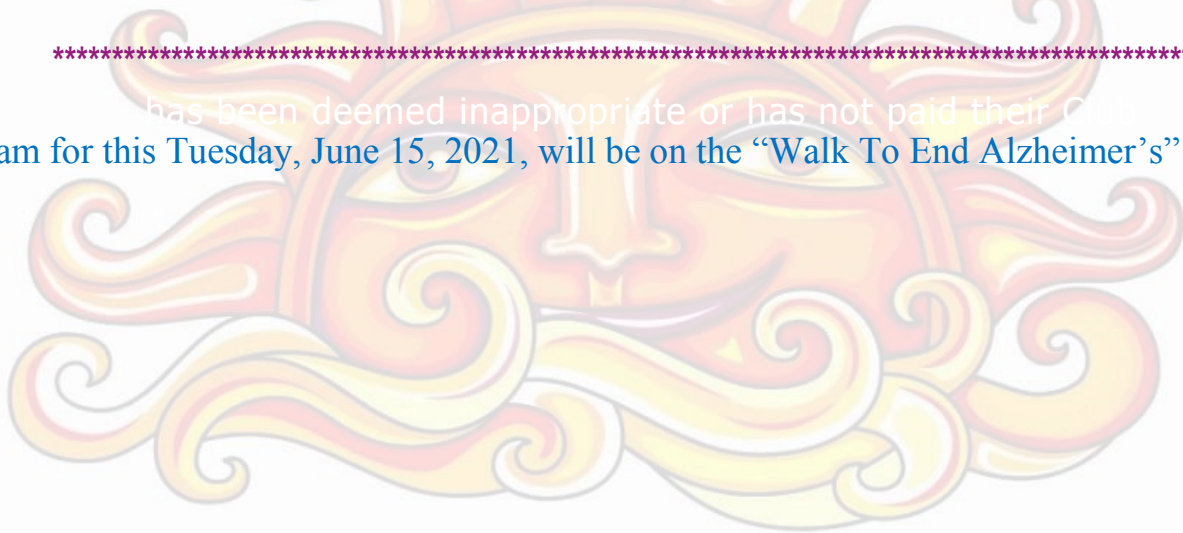

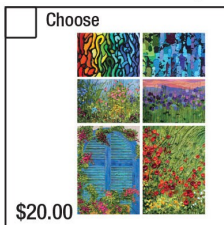

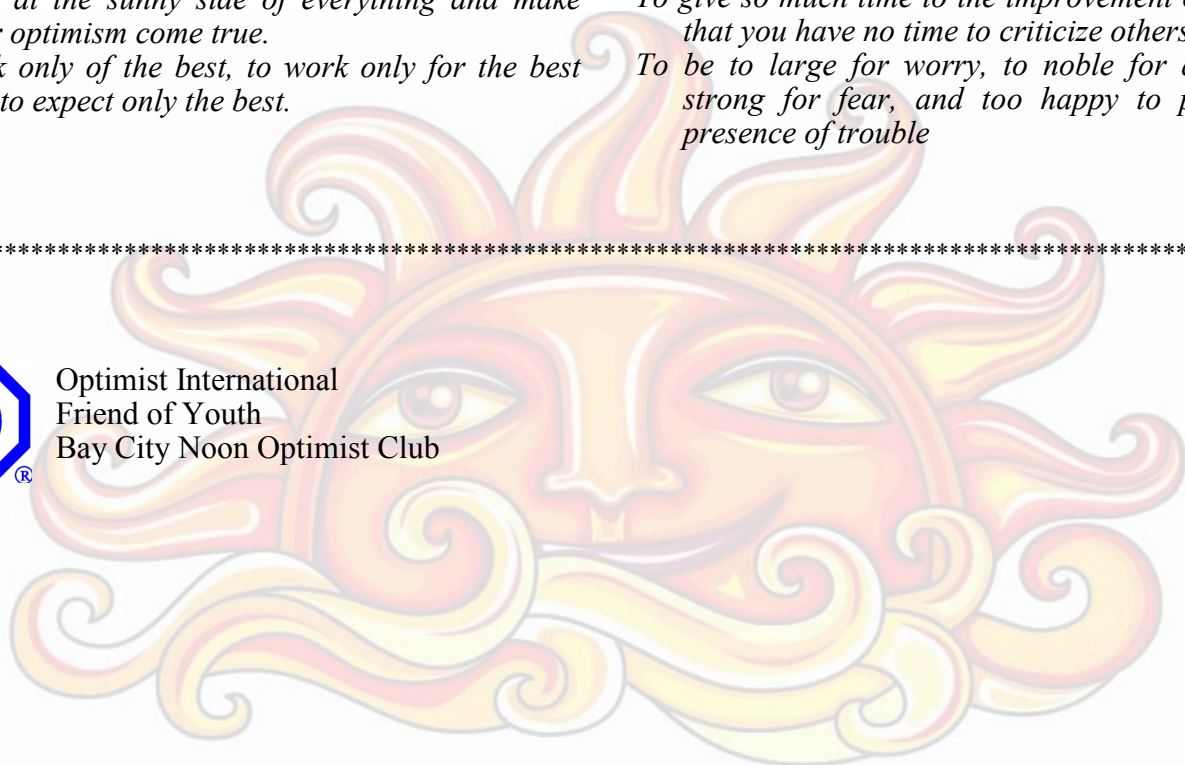
The Optimist Creed
