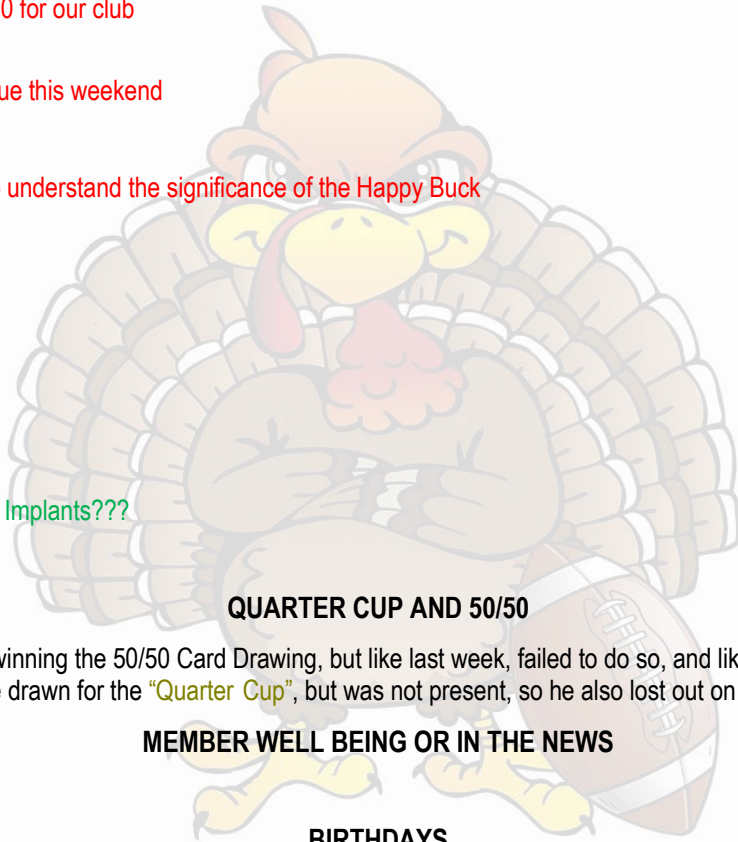

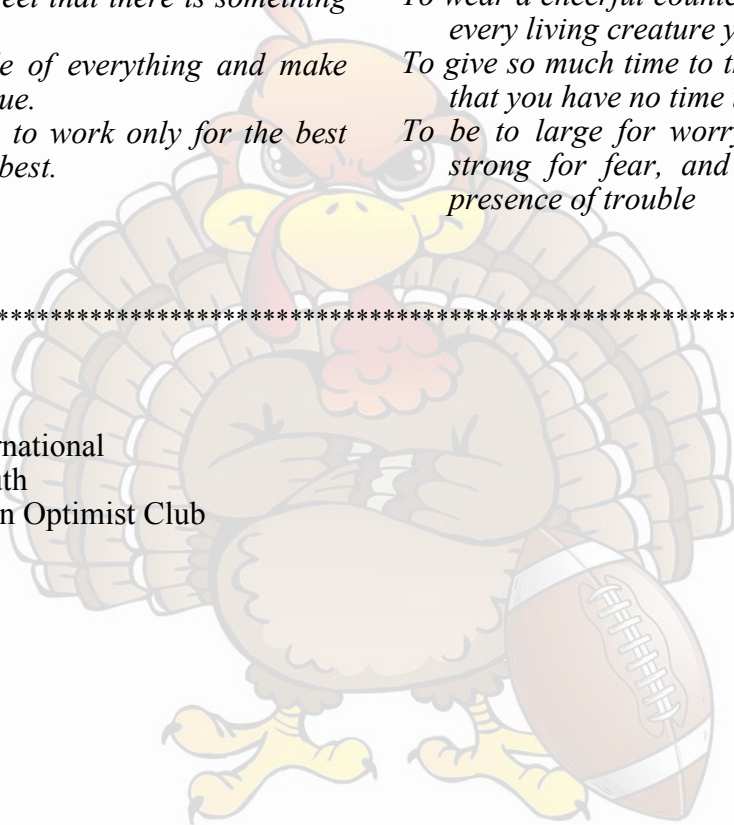
The Optimist Creed
