#### September 20, 2022

President Roberta is vacationing in Paris, France, so while she is gone Vice President Sandy is filling in for her.

Our program today was a field trip to the *Great Lakes Dream Center* in Bay City. Our presenter was *Operations Manager* of the *Dream Center*, **Marlene Mika**. **Marlene** is a long-time member, *and Past President* of our club (2012-2013). The *Dream Centers* were first started in 1994 in Los Angeles by **Mathew** and **Tommy Barnett**, and this year it is celebrating its 25th anniversary. *Dream Centers* in the network are nonprofit faith-based organizations, and the *Great Lakes Dream Center* is part of that network, which now consists of well over 200 centers in the US, and many more worldwide. Each *Dream Center* is independent of each other, and each one is different, depending on the needs of their community. Believing that "One Dream Can Change Generations", *Dream Centers* are helping people trapped in a cycle of poverty find hope, embrace health, and build sustainable lives-for themselves, and their families.

In 2021, the *Great Lakes Dream Center* served over 1450 households, provided over 20,000 diapers for children, helped furnish over 150 households, and saw over 250 people come through the building each week with various needs. While the Center does not offer a food pantry, they do offer a "*Practical Needs*" Pantry. Each week an adult in need can choose 2 kits from the Pantry items available (hygiene items, dish and laundry soaps, diapers, etc). During the cold months coats and blankets are available on racks outside for the taking, as well as inside year-round. The **Bay City Noon Optimist Club** is a proud partner with the Great Lakes Dream Center, helping them with car seats each year. They distribute new car seats to parents in need to help the children to be safe.

The Great Lakes Dream Center is a Community Center that is available to the community to use. People have rented space for weddings, funerals, showers, etc. Local organizations are able to hold their regular meetings there too. Some of the current programs and organizations hosted at the Dream Center include: Alcoholics Anonymous, Narcotics Anonymous, Sex Addicts Anonymous, and Children's Grief Center, just to name a few.
