## What does it mean to be Catholic?

Being Catholic is: to embrace the fullness of the Faith. Acts. Ch. 2 vs. 41-47.

Being Catholic is: to be in fellowship with the *Present living Saints* and in communion with the *glorified Triumphant Saints*. **Hebrews Ch. 12 vs. 1-2; Rev. Ch. 7 vs. 13-15.** 

Being Catholic is: <u>Not</u> a, or being denominational, but is universal, encompassing the entire Community of Faith, Body of Christ, and Church of God. **CCC.pg. 220** 

Being Catholic is: Understanding all the (7) Sacraments of the Church.
