### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- **MIDDLE SCHOOL BAND NIGHT** – This week is middle school band night as we host the 8<sup>th</sup> graders from Teague MS and Rock Lake MS. We would like for this to be an enjoyable and rewarding experience for those students. Please do all that you can to ensure that it is indeed a good experience for the 8<sup>th</sup> graders. If you do not know the answer to a question that might be helpful to them, seek out a leadership member or a section leader. These students are the future of the Brantley Band!
- **BOTTLED WATER** – The students from 5<sup>th</sup> period band will bring in a 24-pack of bottled water by Friday, September 13<sup>th</sup>. Please make sure your name is on the package and place them right outside the uniform room. This is a time extension for this class because of Hurricane Dorian.
- **UNIFORM** - You can put your uniform in the uniform room on Thursday afternoon or Friday morning if you are planning to stay after school for the game. If you are unable to go home before the game, you may stay in the band room after school. Mr. Wharton will be there all afternoon.
- **HALFTIME PERFORMANCE** - This week, we will perform our half-time show with both We Will Rock You/Don't Stop Me Now as well as Crazy Little Thing Called Love. You must stay in uniform for the entire game (unless told otherwise). Your hat, jacket, shoes, etc. must stay on and be worn appropriately for the entire game.
- **CELL PHONES** - Do not bring cell phones or any electronic devices to the game. Leave them in your band lockers or the band office. The game will start at 7:00 p.m. We will march back to the band room at 9:30 p.m. after the game
- **APPLE CANVASSING** –The second Apple Canvassing Date will be Saturday, September 21<sup>st</sup>. This canvassing date is for those that went on the FSU BAND DAY field trip or those that had other conflicts during the first canvassing. Remember that this is our one HUGE fundraiser for the year! Remember to wear your blue band polo, comfortable walking shoes and nice shorts. We will meet at 8:30 am Saturday, September 21<sup>st</sup> in the band room. Anyone that does not participate in one of the apple canvassings will be required to pay a \$50 buy out for the fundraiser as this is the largest fundraiser for the band for the year. Everyone is expected to participate!
- **THANK YOU!** – Thank you to all students and parents that participated in the first Apple Canvassing. Everyone did an awesome job! The second canvassing will be Saturday, September 21<sup>st</sup> at 8:30 a.m. Sign up for that event takes place this week and should include all students who did not participate in the first canvassing.

- **INDIVIDUAL APPLE FAMILY SALES** – In addition to canvassing, all students will participate in Apple Family Sales. Please support the band program by selling apples to your families, colleagues, friends, etc. Each student will receive an individual packet and is asked to sell 5 bags of apples in the Family Sale. The Apple Sales are the biggest band fundraiser of the year. Anyone that does not participate in the family sales will be required to do a \$50 buy out for the fundraiser as this is the largest fundraiser for the band for the year. - **ALL-STATE AUDITIONS** – All-State auditions will be held this week on Saturday, September 14<sup>th</sup> at Lyman High School. Each applicant has a specific audition time that is located on the band office window. Please check that list for your time and room number. Arrive early at Lyman HS and dress for success on Saturday! No jeans, no shorts, no flip flops, no athletic shoes.
- **CONCERT INSTRUMENTS AND MUSIC** – Monday, Wednesday and Thursday of every week will be concert music days for 1<sup>st</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> periods. Please have your appropriate concert instrument, music folder and pencil with you and always be prepared on your concert music. Don't forget to bring the particular mouthpieces and reeds for concert instruments as well!
- **FUNDRAISERS** – Currently, students have the opportunity to participate in The ENJOY THE CITY coupon book fundraiser. Students sell the book for \$25.00 with a \$12.50 profit into their student account.
- **DRY CLEANING** – For all blue jacket uniforms, the first uniform dry-cleaning date for this year was supposed to be after the Lyman game. The second cleaning will take place after the Buchholz game on September 20<sup>th</sup>. For all white jacket uniforms, dry cleaning should take place after every game. Remember that you will need to turn in your receipt to your section leader after you have the uniform cleaned. **IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH STUDENT TO MAKE SURE THAT THEIR UNIFORM IS HUNG OUT TO DRY IMMEDIATELY AFTER EACH PERFORMANCE. THIS WILL PREVENT MILDEW AND SMELL FROM LINGERING ON THE UNIFORM. PARENTS, THANK YOU FOR YOUR HELP IN SEEING THAT PROCEDURE THROUGH TO THE END!**
- **BE PREPARED** – It is your responsibility to be prepared for every performance. Refer to the weekly information sheet which outlines everything you need for the game. If you forget something you must attempt to solve the problem yourself. **MEMORIZE YOUR MUSIC PROPERLY!**
- **APPEARANCE** – Your hair must be above the collar, tucked under your hat, or braided and tucked inside your jacket. Hair must be natural hair color. The bibbers of your uniform should fall an inch or two below the top of the calf. **No jewelry is to be worn. No fingernail polish is to be worn. Gentlemen must be clean shaven.**
