

Instructions for the worksheet.

1. As you notice the worksheet is numbered from one to five.
2. Begin by folding the worksheet right down the center so you have two halves. You should see the “Chapter II” print on the first half and the “Requires zero talent” and the Ben Franklin saying on the other half.
3. Now the “fold here” print should be visible on the first half. Fold the worksheet exactly at this point. If done correctly there should be extra portion of the worksheet just over an inch higher than top of the “Chapter II” section of the worksheet.
4. Fold that extra sheet back over using the top of the worksheet as a guide. Now tuck the top of the worksheet between the flap and you should have a perfect square. Each student now has five distinct lessons from the front, back, and inside of the square.
