Program Overview

Rooted & Rising meets twice a week to balance meaningful academic learning with joyful community connection.

- Tuesdays: Hands-on, literature-based classes in Science, History, and Art, designed to spark creativity, curiosity, and critical thinking, all integrated with a faith-based worldview.
- Thursdays: A time for Chapel, Fellowship, and Open Play, nurturing friendships, practicing social skills, and providing space for children to thrive relationally and spiritually.

Our Approach to Learning

At **Rooted & Rising**, our instructional days are built around **literature-rich**, **hands-on learning experiences** that bring history, science, and art to life.

- History is explored through BookShark's beautifully curated living books and stories, helping children connect personally with the past.
- **Science** follows Sonlight Science, with experiments, discovery, and observation that spark curiosity about God's creation.

- Art projects are thoughtfully designed to align with what students are studying in science and history, encouraging deeper engagement through creativity.
- **Hands-On Projects** from BookShark's Hands-On History Kits give children the opportunity to build, create, and interact with historical concepts in a memorable, tangible way.

Each Tuesday we weave **reading**, **discussion**, **active exploration**, **and creative expression** into a seamless morning of joyful learning.

Thursdays provide the balance of **Chapel, Fellowship, and Open Play**, helping children grow spiritually and relationally as they build strong friendships and practice vital social skills in a supportive, faith-based environment.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is the weekly structure at Rooted & Rising?

Tuesdays provide structured, hands-on learning through faith-integrated **Art, History, and Science** classes.

Thursdays offer a time for **Chapel, Fellowship, and Open Play**, allowing children to build friendships, strengthen social skills, and deepen their faith through shared worship.

2. Why does Rooted & Rising include both structured classes and open play?

We believe a child's education flourishes when both mind and heart are nurtured.

- Instructional time on Tuesdays lays a solid foundation in academics, creativity, and faith-based thinking.
- **Open play** on Thursdays fosters collaboration, empathy, resilience, and communication essential life skills for growing into capable, compassionate individuals. Social interaction is not an "extra"; it is a vital, God-designed part of childhood development.

3. What ages or grades are welcome to enroll?

We welcome children ages **5 to 10** (Kindergarten through 5th Grade). Classes and playgroups are thoughtfully grouped by age to ensure the best possible learning and social experiences.

4. Is Rooted & Rising a faith-based program?

Yes. Rooted & Rising is built on Christian values. Faith is naturally woven into our lessons and daily life, and our Thursday chapel time provides a moment each week for worship, reflection, and growing together in Christ.

5. Can I enroll my child for only one day per week?

Yes. We believe that **both structured learning and open play** are vital for a well-rounded education. Each day complements the other, supporting children's academic, social, and spiritual growth so we prefer you join for both, but it's not mandatory. There is no pricing for a 1-day option.

6. What is expected of parents?

Rooted & Rising is a true co-op — a community effort built by and for families.

- One parent or guardian must remain onsite at all times; this is **not** a drop-off program.
- Parents are encouraged to support the community by building relationships, sharing their strengths, and helping create a nurturing environment for all children. Your involvement will be minimal.
