Instructions for Walter Ashe Card

The "orange" color used for the City and State on the top of the card and for the Name and Address on the bottom right-hand side is as follows when the color combination is used on a graphics program:

Red 255

Green 105

Blue 0

The Font used for the City and State is Arial Black and the size is 11. The City name should be on the left-hand side spaced the same as the "A." in U. S. A. from the right-hand side. The Font used for the operator's name and the address is Arial. The name and address go on two lines with the name centered over the address and a blank line in between. Use Arial at 8 on Microsoft Word for the name and address (less city and state). On the original cards this lettering was definitely considerably smaller than the rest of the lettering.

The call sign is centered between the two horizontal lines and also be centered in the card. Using Microsoft Word Arial at 72 is fine for the size.

The original cards used both black and dark blue for the QSO information, etc. The majority of cards in the K9STH files had the dark blue lettering so that is what was used in this reproduction.

These cards are NOT an exact reproduction of the original Walter Ashe cards. However, there were no cards in the collection at K9STH that did not have handwritten information over the printed text in the QSO information section. Therefore, the text was reproduced with a couple of minor changes.

Again, these are not "exact" reproduction QSL masters. But, they should be "close enough" for those who wish to make their own.
