Opening Prayer and Devotions

Pastor Rod opened the meeting with prayer at 6:03pm.

Pastor's Report

- Pastor Rod expressed his appreciation for the supportive congregation. He reported no current requests for home or hospital visits. He met with Pastor Katie and Pastor Phil regarding ongoing discussions between the two congregations. He hopes that Sunday sermons continue to be meaningful and connected to daily life.
- Pastor Rod offered to send a letter highlighting the December 21 Christmas service and to reach out to members who do not attend regularly. He also provided a list of suggestions to help improve Sunday attendance, which the Council will review moving forward.

Church Secretary Report

- The church internet service was upgraded in November at no cost and is working well.
- A new copier was purchased for \$100 after the office printer failed in October. A new drum and toner were also purchased for another \$68.02. The new printer is functioning well.
- Accounts are current. Several double payments were identified and resolved. The Town of Reardan bill will continue to be paid by check due to added online payment fees.
- Cintas installed the AED. Barbara Hamilton will work with Doug Bonstrom to schedule training for congregation members.

Financial Reports – November

- The financial report for November was reviewed. Several line items were discussed including the decreased rent for November. A new dishwasher was purchased by the tenants and, with approval from the council, the amount was subtracted from the monthly rent. Barbara Hamilton moved and Gary Cook seconded to approve the report. Motion carried.

Committee Reports

- Stewardship – No report
- Worship & Music and Outreach & Fellowship – Report by Buddi Williams
Thank you to all who donated potatoes or contributed funds for the Thanksgiving boxes. A total of 51 boxes were distributed, with a similar number expected for Christmas.
Thank you to everyone who selected a name tag or donated funds for the Tree of Sharing. The congregation continues to be generous.
Nancy will be contacting volunteers to bring food for the Annual Meeting Brunch.
- Property & Remodeling – Report by Gary Cook
All annual air filters have been replaced.

Gary noted concerns about a window allowing air into the building. Charlotte believes the issue is likely with the office window frame. Gary will continue investigating.

- Endowment – Report by Barbara Hamilton

The following scholarships were awarded for the Spring (postmarked by October 31, 2025). These will be sent to the colleges in January.

Old Business

- Review of Budget Recommendations from Stewardship Committee

The Council recommends that each committee be permitted to spend a portion of its annual budget without prior Council approval. For example, the Property Committee may spend up to \$500 (one-third of its annual budget) independently, with receipts submitted to the church.

- US Bank Closing in Reardan

With the Reardan US Bank branch closing, the Council is researching options for transferring church accounts. Charlotte presented information regarding STCU's fees and account options. Discussion included how any changes could impact the Endowment Committee and whether congregational input will be required. Exploration and consultation will continue.

- Prayers for Other Congregations

Earlier this year, a church in Idaho informed us that they had prayed for our congregation. The Council expressed appreciation and agreed that Emmanuel should offer similar prayers for other congregations. Barbara Hamilton contacted the Synod and received a list of 86 congregations. Barbara Hamilton moved to begin praying for all Synod congregations starting in January and continuing until the list is complete. Gary Cook seconded. Motion carried.

- Call Committee Membership

Emily Zwainz and Jim Baye have offered to serve on the call committee. The council also suggested several other congregants that would be assets and we will discuss with those people to determine their interest. Council would like to be able to introduce the committee at the Annual meeting in January,

New Business

- Congregational Survey in Preparation for Call Process

Several members of the congregation suggested gathering feedback through an anonymous survey regarding the needs of the church as we begin the pastoral call process. The Council recommends that the Call Committee begin its work with the creation and distribution of this survey.

- Open Council Position in 2026

The council discussed options for Tessa's open position beginning in January 2026.

Closing

The meeting closed with the Lord's Prayer at 7:29pm.
