# COWBOY DAYS and O'ODHAM TASH PARADE

## RULES & REGULATIONS

In order to provide a safe and enjoyable environment for the Cowboy Days and O'Odham Tash Parade, the following rules have been initiated to accomplish these goals.

### GENERAL INFORMATION:

- All vehicle drivers must have a valid driver's license and vehicle proof of liability insurance. A copy of your vehicle insurance with the minimum state statutory limits must be received by **Friday, Feb 11**
- All drivers must have an unobstructed view of the road.
- Have your entry number on each side of your entry (You will receive this at check-in)
- No sign boards or bill boards will be allowed as a float entry.
- **No handouts** – candy, food, flyers, brochures, pamphlets, etc. No items of any kind should be distributed or thrown

### SAFETY REGULATIONS:

- Float size cannot exceed 14' in height or 12' in width. Length must be short enough to navigate sharp turns with ease.
- All floats/vehicles must have wheel guards on rear wheels.
- The hitch used to attach the float to the pulling vehicle will be factory "receiver" type or welded pickup style bumper. No "bolt-on" type hitches will be allowed.
- Each float will have two marshals—one at the front left corner and one at the right rear corner.
- A minimum of one (1) 2A10BC type fire extinguisher must be provided on each float or unit.
- **Sitting on hoods or trunks of vehicles is prohibited.**
- No participant will get on or off a moving vehicle or float.
- Any bicycle rider must wear a helmet.
- If animals are on your float, they must be on a leash and held by an adult at all times. If you have an animal walking, they must be on a leash and accompanied by an adult.

### EQUESTRIAN ENTRIES:

- All equestrian entries must have full control of horse throughout the entire parade route.
- **All equestrian groups are required to have their own clean-up team (pooper scoopers)**

### DAY OF THE PARADE:

Parade check-in will begin at 8:00 am on Saturday, 2/19/2022. You must be in your designated space by 9:45 am, your parade number will be given to you at the time you check in for the parade. The Parade is scheduled to begin at 10 am sharp!
